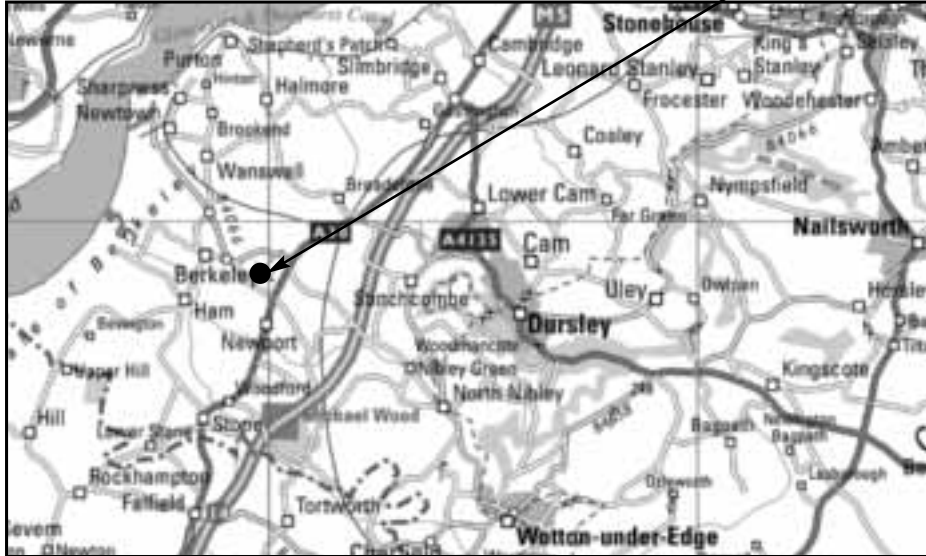

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**DIRECTIONS to Alkington Farm, Alkington Lane, Berkeley, Gloucestershire, GL13 9PL**

Alkington Farm is located less than 5 minutes from the A38 and almost equidistant between J13 (Stroud) and J14 (Thornbury) of the M5 and is within 0.5 miles of the Applegates Coach Station which abuts the A38. From J14 (Falfield/Thornbury) head west on the B4509 then north on the A38 towards Gloucester for approximately 5 miles travelling through the villages of Stone and Newport then turning left off A38 onto Alkington Lane sign posted Berkeley. Alkington Farm can be found ¼ mile on the left hand side.

Alternatively, from the north leave the M5 at J13 (Stroud) continue west on the A419 and then South on the A38 for approximately 7 miles and then turning right into Alkington Lane immediately adjacent to Applegates Coaches.
