### 23 COWS & CALVES & 6 GRAZING COWS

11.30 am – Auctioneers: Arthur White.

A very smart four year old Angus Cow with her 3 month Angus x steer calf at foot topped at £1400 from RP & RM Dew with other Cow and steer calf units to £1340, £1260 and £1230.

The Dispersal of Simmental Cows with Simmental x calves at foot from the Exors of Colin Clutterback met a good trade which was well supported by the general trade and friends of Colin. A smart Blue Simmental Cow with her 6 month Simmental steer at foot sold to £895 with another good Simmental Cow and Calf heading off to Churcham at £820. Most of the smaller cows with calves sold £600 - £700 with the younger cows and smaller calves £550 to £600. The strong Cows look good value for money, but the dry weather certainly now taking a toll and affecting the trade to some degree. In the grazing section a 14 year old Simmental Cow to £680 (104 ppkg), 8 year Simmental Cow to £920 (135ppkg), Aberdeen Angus Cow 7 years to £690 (127 ppkg), Simmental Cow 9 years old to £840 (129 ppkg). Good trade.

### 232 STORE CATTLE

11.30 am – Auctioneers: Arthur White & Jon Pullin  
Averages: Steers £771 (177p/kg), Heifers £721 (166p/kg)

A superb entry for mid July and perhaps a few more on offer due to the dry spell we are experiencing; although the trade has slipped in all areas cattle still look to be very well sold in the circumstances.

Only a handful of stronger framed cattle on offer which traded between £1070 and £1175 (183-195 ppkg) topping at £1175 (193p) for British Blue steers from Messrs Hillman, Malmesbury.

The medium term stores just a touch easier than a fortnight ago, but on a par with last week's trading £820-£950 with a bit more interest in the lesser quality and dairy bred sorts.

Pedigree heifers from M S Potter, Goosey, sold to £900 with the better heifers 180-190 ppkg generally. E J Greenhill topped at £1065 (171p) for a 32 month British Blue heifer. A dispersal of cattle for the late Mary Organ from Garsden, Malmesbury saw her Angus heifer to £1050 and her 30 month heifer to £1000,

her Simmental grazing Cow made £915 earlier in the day.

The younger weaned sorts met a good trade for type with 10 month steers from C Clutterback to £440 (220 ppkg) and £555 (222ppkg), Simmental steers from Chris White, Newent at £580 (241 ppkg) and Hereford steers at £500 (227 ppkg). J A Hobbs, Elmore sold a good pen of Blue steers 10-11 months at £610 (210 ppkg) and Aberdeen Angus steers to £518 (175 ppkg). A P & SG Clark sold a good pen of British Blue steers 11-13 months at £625 (173 ppkg). A super bunch of 15-16 month Hereford x heifers out of British Blue cows from Mike Inwood looked good value at £792 (168 ppkg).
