Heifer trade very strong with best British Blues to £272 and Hereford to £250.

A run of weaned calves saw Friesians to £222 from C Lloyd and breeding Shorthorn heifers to £212 from C F Harwood.

Another pleasing entry for early June sold to a very good trade throughout. The stronger farming short term steers were a very good trade with 30 grand Continental steers from Mr C Hill, Headley being the highlight of the sale and topping at £1402 (197p/kg), £1398 (207p/kg), £1375 (202p/kg) & £1260 (203p/kg). The stronger native breeds saw Aberdeen Angus to £1140 (194p/kg) & South Devon's to £1140 (190p/kg) from the same home & Hereford steers to £1138 (189p/kg) from M/s T & S Pain, Tortworth.

The better medium term, farming steers (15 - 20mths generally) traded over £1000 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1075 (224p/kg) from M/s A & V Alburt & Sons, Winchcombe with the general sorts £880 - £950 (180 - 190p/kg).

A few Friesian steers saw a top of 835 (153p/kg) & £808 (158p/kg) from M/s T & S Pain, Tortworth. The medium types were generally £700 - £760 (150 - 170p/kg).

Not much strength in the heifer section with a top of £1050 (143p/kg) for an overage Aberdeen Angus from M/s C Harber & Son, Earls Croome. The few stronger farming sorts were £900 - £950 (190 - 195p/kg) with the medium type sorts £730 - £840 (170 - 180p/kg).

Another good trade on a mixed show of weaned calves & young stores with young Aberdeen Angus steers (4 - 5mths) to £400 (285p/kg) from M/s K & C Gough, Marlborough with their heifers to £290 (241p/kg). The rest were mostly dairy bred heifers trading between £350 - £450 (150 - 160p/kg)

Nearly double the amount to last week & similar numbers to this sale last year. The early part of the week saw better trades with the trade easing in centres today. The sale included the Royal Three Counties Show Lamb Competition with some good commercial lambs on offer but very few real show lambs. The very best lambs traded to 343p/kg £120 for 35kg from Miss Fay Mustoe for the Champion lambs (3<sup>rd</sup> Overall in Carcass competition). The Reserve Champions to 306p/kg £110 for 36kg from M/s P & C Houldey (4<sup>th</sup> Overall in Carcass competition). The good commercial lambs were 250 – 260p/kg topping at 267p/kg £111 for 41½kg from M/s J M Hanson & Son. The general run saw a lot of lambs 33 – 36kg and were 235 – 245p/kg around £82 - £85 a head. Very few heavier lambs sold to a top of £120 for 49½kg from Mr G Sivell.
