Avg: Steers £848 (180p/kg), Heifers £675 (165p/kg)

Another very good entry sold to another good, slightly sharper trade with again some good farming cattle on offer. The uncertainty of Brexit not helping the beef trade with Irish meat flooding the shelves therefore the stronger cattle no dearer.

Again not too many real strong, short term cattle on offer topping at £1180 (160p/kg) for Simmental steers from M/s H C Jones & Son, Bourton & £1172 (155p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus steer from M/s L B Cook & Family, Bisley.

A very good show of stronger farming sorts saw the Continental steers a good trade between £1020 - £1100 (165 - 185p/kg). The general Continental steers were well sold between £920 - £1020 (175 - 195p/kg). The younger Continental steers were a good, firm trade between £800 - £900 (185 - 200p/kg).

A good show of farming native breeds met a slightly firmer trade with a top of £1080 (178p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from Mr B J Baker, Pewsham & Hereford steers to £1102 (151p/kg) from M/s L B Cook & Family, Bisley.

The Friesian steers saw a top of £798 (147p/kg) & £658 (132p/kg) from M/s E, R & M Ractliffe, Harescombe. The stronger sorts were generally £650 - £700 (130 - 140p/kg).

A good show of stronger farming heifers saw Charolais' topping at £960 (184p/kg) from M/s Millard Bros, Coopers Hill & £935 (170p/kg) from M/s E, R & M Ractliffe, Harescombe. The stronger sorts were generally £870 - £920 (160 - 170p/kg) with the good younger farming sorts were £750 - £850 (170 - 180p/kg) & the general sorts well sold between £680 - £780 (150 - 160p/kg). A good trade on the native breeds topping at £902 (159p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus again from M/s E, R & M Ractliffe, Harescombe.

The weaned calves saw a wonderful run of 121 Aberdeen Angus (10 - 11mths) from M/s Barley Park Farms, Ducklington selling to £932 (196p/kg), £848 (214p/kg), £845 (196p/kg), £802 (208p/kg) for the steers. The heifers sold to £765 (180p/kg), £685 (185p/kg), £675 (170p/kg) & £670 (176/kg). Simmental steers (11 - 12mths) from Mr J G Daniels, Turkdean sold to £798 (202p/kg) & £790 (205p/kg) with his heifers to £675 (182p/kg) & £610 (164p/kg).

Numbers starting to dry up with us as many now finished with hoggets and turn to lambing. Trade was similar to last week with the best handyweight hoggets a very good trade between 198 - 203p/kg topping at 205p/kg £84 for 41kg from Upper Horns Farm. The general handyweights were also well sold in comparison between 185 - 190p/kg.

The medium weight 45 - 48kg hoggets are still most difficult to sell but a shade firmer this week with most £80 - £82. The heavier hoggs were again as dear as anywhere this week with the better sorts were £85 - £88 topping at £90 for 60kg from Mr C T Hicks.
