Shorter entry, sharper trade. A handful of Friesians saw best sorts £80+ to a top of £88 from FE White & Sons. Some super Continental Bulls from Anton Smith topped at £402, £445 (twice) and a few at £380+, Simmentals to £422 for EJ Pike & Son. Best £380+, mediums £300-£320 small plain calves £200. A few best Native calves made £320 and £350 for R Beard & Son Hereford £292 - £320 for AR & M Highman. Heifers much firmer £318, £340 and £352 for Blues from DJ & NJ Wall and Anton Smith, Natives to £220/£250 for the best from Perry Beard and AR & M Highman.

A handful of cows & calves of mostly plain, old or fractious traded between £610 - £672 for Limousin & Simmental's with Limousin x heifer calves (2 - 7mths).

### 281 STORE CATTLE

A reasonable entry met a good, solid trade with the mostly farming cattle on offer & very few younger stores.

The strong, near meat cattle seemed well sold trading between £1180 - £1300 topping at £1385 (171p/kg) for Simmental steers from M/s N J Pearson & Son, Bledington. The strong, meat heifers were in short supply trading near to £1100 topping at £1280 (171p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from Mr W Pearson, Bledington.

The stronger farming steers traded between £1020 - £1100 (170 - 175p/kg) topping at £1190 (185p/kg) for Charolais steers from Mr S K Batt, Longhope. The general well grown farming steers traded between £920 - £1030 (175 - 185p/kg) & the younger sorts £850 - £950 (190 - 200p/kg).

The Friesian steers saw the stronger sorts over £800 (138 - 150p/kg) topping at £988 (162p/kg) & £905 (138p/kg) from M/s T Rymer & Son, Uley. The medium sorts were £600 - £700 (120 - 135p/kg).

The stronger farming heifers traded between £860 - £930 (160 - 170p/kg) topping at £990 (180p/kg) for British Blue's from M/s G Maidment & Son, Cleverton. The general farming types seemed well sold between £650 - £750 (165 - 180p/kg) with a few more customers for Hereford heifers to bull.

The younger stores saw Simmental steers (9mths) to £815 (212p/kg) from M/s D & B Minett, Blockley & Hereford steers (8 - 10mths) to £690 (215p/kg) from M/s Bydemill Farms, Hannington.

A few more forward but of all shapes & sizes met a similar trade but all centres today a shade easier than yesterday but the same as the start of the week.

The better shaped meated lambs traded between 172 – 180p/kg topping at 192p/kg £84.50 for 44g from Mr R Richins. The general commercial lambs were 167 – 172p/kg with the looser coated & leaner types 160 – 165p/kg generally. The heavier sorts 46 – 50kg were a shade firmer with the better sorts £78 - £80.

A good entry saw a similar trade but a larger percentage of medium & lesser ewes on offer. The real strong ewes with the few stronger Suffolk & Continental ewes traded between £75 - £84 with Mules to £58 - £65. The half meated & smaller meat ewes traded between £60 - £65 with the leaner grazing ewes were between £43 - £54. The extremely plain sorts & lesser types £25 - £35 generally. Rams sold to £99.

The beef saw a few better sorts (mostly R grades) traded between 195 – 199p/kg with the general sorts 180 – 185p/kg & the leaner or lesser shaped sorts 160 – 170p/kg.

A good entry & trade on the cows with no real top cows on offer. The better meated beef cows traded between 138 – 148p/kg topping at 151p/kg for a Limousin from Mr R Bovill. The medium beef cows were 118 – 125p/kg with leaner or over fat types 105 – 110p/kg.

The dairy cows saw the better meat to 130p/kg from M/s R & A Batt with the leaner types 80 – 90p/kg & plain cows 60 – 77p/kg.
