68 REARING CALVES

Bulls £465 Heifers £282

Recently, I have noted new vendors bringing calves to us for which we are very grateful. One or two have attended to compare their private calves sold off farm to those we are selling. As an example a new Vendor today traded four calves with us and stated an overall average required which if we achieved came with the promise of more calves to come; they went home with £500 more than they wanted to achieve! I hope they and the regular loyal supporters will pass this note onto others who use other methods to sell their calves, no more needs to be said!

Today's trade was exceptional and one of the best shows of calves seen for some time and what a difference 10 days on the milk does for a calf and the trade achievable.

Black and whites of medium and best quality sold well; £95 - £100 generally topping at £105 for IA & HS Godwin and at £130 for MD Pike, third quality will sold at £20 - £40.

The Continental bull trade very strong. Blonde's to £428 and £385 for DE Meredith and the 10 top British Blue bulls all over £380 with £465 for B Gough & Son and 6 from JR & ED Newton £415 - £458 another cracker from JR & SE Cook at £445. Medium British Blue £300 - £340. B Gough made £420 of his Simmental bull whilst DJ Spratt, Aust sent tremendous Charolais bulls at £395 and £455. A handful of Native bulls saw Aberdeen Angus to £320 and £370 from R&R Baker Ltd.

In the heifer section the best Continentals again very well sold, the medium types on par with recent weeks, but perhaps the best heifers £10/£15 per head easier to buy. That said the best British Blue heifers £272 to £282 from JR & ED Newton with Charolais to £252 for DJ Spratt and Simmental to £245 for MD Pike. These calves all £50 - £80 better off for staying on the cows. R&R Baker Ltd sold similar type calves of Angus breeding at £205 and £220, medium Herefords £130 - £140.

A sprinkling of weaned calves saw British Blue steers sell very well to achieve £430 with Aberdeen Angus from J Legge at £380. British Blue heifers got to £405 and Angus heifers again from the Leggs at £315.

A run of cows & calves from M/s R & R Dew, Harborough Magna saw their Charolais cow & 2 Aberdeen Angus x steer calves (8mths) totalling £2520. Aberdeen Angus heifers with Aberdeen Angus heifer calves (6mths) sold to £1372 & £1320 from the same home.

A British Blue x heifer & her Aberdeen Angus x steer calf (3mths) sold to £1310 from Mr C McNally, King Sutton.

Grazing cows saw Simmental's to £1008 (168p/kg) from M/s J & E Goulding, Newent.

135 STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £1040 (203p/kg), Heifers £880 (182p/kg)

A short entry but probably one of the best shows of cattle anywhere around. If you had come to buy cattle then it was not for the faint hearted with an astronomical trade with some up £50 a head on last week's flyer. The short term farming steers met a very good trade reaching over £1170 (195 - 210p/kg) topping at £1245 (204p/kg), £1202 (210p/kg), £1178 (193p/kg), £1170 (201p/kg & £1168 (220p/kg) for a run of non-farm assured Limousin steers from M/s C J Warr & Sons, Corston.

The stronger farming cattle saw some wonderful cattle selling between £1100 - £1150 (210 - 220p/kg) to a top of £1225 (224p/kg) from M/s J & E Goulding, Newent. The younger farming cattle (15 - 20mths) went up another gear and saw the better sorts £1050 - £1100 (220 - 230p/kg) topping at £1175 (223p/kg) for a Limousin steer (14mths) from Mr M Hillman, Rodbourne & £1148 (227p/kg) from Mr J Bennett, Newent. The better bred cattle (12 - 14mths) were generally £950 - £1050 with a Limousin steer to £1088 (244p/kg) from M/s E Greenhill & Son, Rodbourne.

Very few native steers met an extremely good trade with Aberdeen Angus to £1100 (180p/kg) from M/s G Denton & Family, Thatcham & Hereford's to £1060 (225p/kg) from M/s D Rumming & Sons, Lydiard Tregoze.

Only a few Friesian steers on offer selling to £870 (141p/kg) from Mr B Hillier, Minety.

The stronger short term heifers traded around the £1100 mark topping at £1152 (190p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s G Denton & Family, Thatcham. The stronger, farming sorts were £970 - £1040 (190 - 200p/kg) with the younger & lesser sorts £840 - £900.

A good entry saw trade similar but a shade easier to last week. Meat is what's wanted and the best shaped, meat lambs selling to a premium over 200p/kg topping at 210p/kg £82 for 39kg from Mr A Goscombe & 209p/kg £90 for 43kg from Mr R Richins. The general run of lambs were 188 – 195p/kg with the leaner sorts now worth as much in the stores 180 – 185p/kg. A few lightweight lambs 33 – 35kg were £57 - £62. Only a handful of heavier lambs selling between to £88 - £95 topping at £101 for 56kg from M/s Barley Park Farms.
