Bulls £432, Heifers £298

Today's trade much firmer with a few more buyers around the ring just making the difference. A Friesian from E J Pike with possibly some Beef x in it made £305, other Friesians £60 - £70 as a comparable. Best British Blues bulls £365+, 5 above that to a top of £432 for JR & SE Cook. Simmentals to £380 from Roy Townsend. Other Native bulls saw Shorthorn to £260 from R & R Baker, Best Aberdeen Angus £322, £330 and £350 all from R Beard & Son. Heifers mainly British Blues much firmer on the week; top Blues £200+ topping at £298 for JR & ED Newton, 7 over £200. Aberdeen Angus heifers avg £175 topping at £248 for Rawlings & Davis, Hereford heifers to £255 and £250 twice from M E Hinchwick. Best Simmentals sold to £265 from RT & EB Townsend. 4 weaned Friesian Bulls, 3 months made £250 per head.

Steers Avg £960 (188p/kg), Heifers Avg £712 (178p/kg)

A pleasing entry sold to a very good trade and probably the dearest for some time with the ring full of spring buyers out looking for cattle. The entry saw a remarkable 80% being native breeds in both the steer & heifer sections. The stronger farming steers were well sold up some £30 - £50 on last week trading between £1100 - £1180 (185 - 200p/kg) topping at £1258 (183p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from Mr G Evans, Moreton Valence. A run of mostly Aberdeen Angus steers from M/s B, C & N Ford, Driffield sold to £1205 (191p/kg), £1152 (195p/kg) & £1132 (188p/kg). The younger farming steers were £900 - £1000 (185 - 205p/kg). Only a few Friesian steers on offer with the stronger sorts over £900 topping at £1090 (142p/kg) from M/s P & R Jenner, Cirencester. The farming sorts were £690 - £750 (151 - 158p/kg).

The heifers were also a much dearer trade with the near meat sorts to £1205 (161p/kg) & £1200 (151p/kg) from M/s P & R Jenner, Cirencester. The stronger farming types were £1000 - £1100 (180 - 190p/kg) topping at £1125 (206p/kg) for outlying Limousin heifers from M/s A & W Hancock, Slad. The younger farming heifers were generally £800 - £950 (180 - 190p/kg).

A good trade on the weaned calves with Aberdeen Angus steers (7 - 9mths) to £745 (219p/kg) & £640 (224p/kg) from Mr M Wood, Minety. Pedigree Hereford heifers (7 - 8mths) sold to £520 (173p/kg) from Mr J Riley, Towcester.

Licenses must be obtained from Animal Health by Monday, 22nd January 2018

APPLYING FOR A LICENCE HAS NOW CHANGED

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (tb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to CSC.TBlicensing@apha.gis.gov.uk

APHA, Polwhele, Truro, Cornwall, TR4 9AD

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home. The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.
