A very good trade for what was on offer with the better sorts well sold topping at £1290 for a Limousin heifer & her Hereford x heifer calf from M/s F Stow & Son, Bledington. A Hereford heifer & her young Limousin heifer calf sold to £1280 from Mr S Potter, Grittleton & Simmental cows & their young heifer calves sold to £1230 & £1225 from M/s E Amesbury, Leckhampstead. The general run traded between £1100 - £1180. The medium cows & calves were £950 - £1000. Incalf cows sold to £970 for a Hereford from Miss E Smith, Leigh.

Another pleasing entry sold to another very good trade and probably a shade dearer on all sorts.

The stronger, short term farming steers traded between £1100 - £1195 (185 - 210p/kg) topping at £1220 (180p/kg) for a Beef Shorthorn steer from Mr I Clapton, Cranham. The medium term, stronger farming steers saw the better sorts £1080 - £1130 (190 - 210p/kg) topping at £1192 (205p/kg) for Bazadaise steers from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton. The general stronger steers were £1000 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg).

The younger & medium steers were again well sold between £800 - £900 (185 - 220p/kg).

The Friesian steers saw a top of £930 (170p/kg) from Mrs G Greenaway, Cirencester with the stronger sorts in short supply & generally £870 - £900 (150 - 165p/kg). The medium steers were £700 - £800 (150 - 160p/kg) with a few younger & extreme sorts £520 - £550 (100 - 130p/kg).

The stronger, short term farming heifers were around £1100 topping at £1148 (185p/kg) for a Beef Shorthorn from Mr I Clapton, Cranham & Friesian heifers to £1125 (145p/kg) from M/s J D Wright & Son, Baydon.

The stronger farming heifers were in shorter supply & again a very good trade between £875 - £1000 (185 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £780 - £880 (190 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

The weaned calves saw a wonderful run of Limousin's (10 - 12mths) from M/s P James & Partners, Old Sodbury saw the steers to £1000 (243p/kg), £990 (238p/kg) & £925 (256p/kg) & the heifers £875 (203p/kg) & £808 (212p/kg). A pedigree Aberdeen Angus heifer (11mths) sold to £800 (188p/kg) from Ms T Griffin, Whelford. Limousin steers (11 - 13mths) sold to £990 (257p/kg) from M/s T Limbrick & Son, Sherborne & (12mths) to £945 (214p/kg) from Miss M Allen, Blaisdon.

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

Meat is still the key with the good meat hoggets still 240 - 250p/kg topping at 251p/kg £108 for 43kg from M/s M J C Hocken & Sons. The general run of meat hoggs were 225 - 235p/kg. The leaner sorts were well between 190 - 210p/kg dependent on breed.

The heavier hoggets again saw the meat well sold with the very best topping at £141 for 62½kg from M/s D & R Williams & Son. The general run were £115 - £120 with the leaner or lesser breeds £100 - £110.

A few sheep pushing teeth and are generally £20 a head less so keep drawing.
