



# CIRENCESTER LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

**TUESDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2021**

## 25 REARING & WEANED CALVES

10.30 am – Auctioneer: Richard Barrow  
Rearing Bulls to £335, Avg £245, Heifers to £305, Avg £173

A strong trade throughout today with the best, strongest calves looking the best value. British Blue bulls topped at £335 from M/s A Webb & Son with medium Blues generally £200 - £250. Bazadaise bulls from Mr D Meredith sold to £305 & Simmental's to £325 from M/s R & T Andrews & £300 & £295 from M/s E Pike & Son. Native calves still a good trade with a run of Aberdeen Angus bulls £275 - £295 from M/s R C Ponting & Son with Hereford's to £265 from Mr H J Vincent. 2 British Friesian bulls were £205 & £155 again from M/s E Pike & Son. British Blue heifers topped at £305 from M/s Rawlings & Davis with Aberdeen Angus to £205 from M/s R C Ponting & Son.

## 130 STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £1020 (218p/kg), Heifers £917 (203p/kg)

A shorter entry with a trade that continues to fly. Not too many stronger sorts on offer but some good medium term farming sorts forward.

The stronger short-term steers continue at extremely high levels trading between £1290 - £1320 (220 - 230p/kg) topping at £1400 (200p/kg) for a Hereford from M/s C & R Mills, Cirencester. The stronger medium-term steers were mostly native steers trading between £1080 - £1200 (220 - 230p/kg) topping at £1290 (239p/kg) & £1200 (231p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from Mr C Goodman, Braydon.

The younger & general dairy bred steers seemed very well sold between £900 - £1000 (215 - 240p/kg) topping at £1190 (205p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers (15mths) from M/s B J Arkell & Partners, Whelford.

Only a few Friesian steers sold to £892 (158p/kg) from Mr L Lewis, Brinkworth.

A good show of short term or stronger medium term mostly native heifers saw Aberdeen Angus to £1150 (195p/kg) & £1120 (218p/kg) from Mr C Goodman, Braydon & £1130 (213p/kg) from M/s B J Arkell & Partners, Whelford. Continental heifers topped at £1175 (210p/kg) for British Blue's from Mr A R Jones, Stockend.

The general medium-term heifers were mostly £1000 - £1050 (195 - 215p/kg) with the few younger heifers being mostly Aberdeen Angus trading between £800 - £980 (195 - 205p/kg).

A few weaned calves saw Aberdeen Angus steers (5mths) to £588 (245p/kg) from Mr L Lewis, Brinkworth with his British Blue steer (3mths) to £490 (272p/kg).

A similar number forward has seen a lift in the trade this week with numbers tightening. As recent weeks weight and meat the easiest sold but all were a fantastic trade for the time of year with £100 mostly the price for lambs 38kg to 41kg. The best meat tight coated lambs traded between 255 – 270p/kg topping at 276p/kg £94 for 34kg from Poole Farming. The general lambs traded between 240 – 250p/kg with only a few lesser breed lambs 230 – 240p/kg. The heavier sorts were in demand with 45 – 50kg lambs £115 - £120 and the over 50kg to £136 for 55kg from Mr J Theyer.

The half meat & meat medium Suffolk & Continental ewes still selling well between £105 - £115. The leaner grazing & plain ewes traded generally £80 - £90 and the plain & very plain ewes & lesser breeds £60 - £70.
