70 REARING CALVES

Bulls £410, Heifers £300

A really good entry and a buoyant trade with an excellent number of buyers in attendance particularly with the weather so good.

16 Friesians averaged a good £86 to a top of £140 for MJ & JC Vaughan and an additional rearing buyer giving all of this type a boost.

Native's fewer on the ground to £255 for a good Hereford from HJ Vincent. Best Continentals to £410 (British Blue) and £400 (British Blue) from DJ & NJ Wall and JR & SE Cook with two superb Simmental bulls from J Stagg & Sons at £400 each. Bazadaise sold to £360 for MT & I Scott & Son.

Heifer trade really good, Blonde twice to £242 from DE Meredith, £270 and £300 for British Blues from JR & SE Cook, £250 for B Gough's Simmental. Native trade good; Aberdeen Angus and Hereford to £138 - £150 for smaller sorts out of summer calving heifers.

3 month weaned Aberdeen Angus bull calves from VS Legge, Lydney at £220 - similar aged heifers from same home at £198.

A short entry with very little quality and trade a shade firmer on the better sorts but the lesser sorts very selective with the lack of grass & dropping finished prices now taking effect.

A few stronger farming cattle on offer trading around the £1000 with steers to £1045 (178p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s E Greenhill & Son, Rodbourne & heifers to £1120 (150p/kg) for an overage Aberdeen Angus from the late Ms M Organ, Garsden. The better younger farming steers & heifers were generally £700 - £800 (165 - 180p/kg).

When the trade starts to be effected the first thing to suffer is the out of spec sorts with quite a few cattle showing signs of the weather or very small for age these were sold between £250 - £350 with many buyers not wanting them at any price.

A few Friesian steers saw the stronger sorts to £772 (154p/kg) from M/s R & B Kingston & Sons, Wotton under Edge & Norwegian Red steers to £960 (154p/kg) from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton. Mediums were £525 - £618 (120 - 135p/kg)

A few cows & calves saw a Hereford cow & her Aberdeen Angus bull calf to £780 from M/s C B Powell & Son, Shurdington. British Blue grazing cows to £1060 (135p/kg) from the late Ms M Organ, Garsden.

Hard to describe the trade on the beef cattle as very few fitted any spec. The few saw Aberdeen Angus steers to 190p/kg & heifers 180p/kg from M/s R & W Whatley. Lean or overage steers were 140 – 150p/kg. Lean Deters 90 – 100p/kg. The cows have just eased everywhere slightly with a smart Bazadaise cow topping at 154p/kg from M/s P & T Akers. Meat Friesian's to 135p/kg from M/s Burcher, Son & Jones. Medium cows were 112 – 125p/kg. Leaner sorts 80 – 100p/kg generally.
