



# CIRENCESTER LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

## 123 REARING CALVES

10.30 am - Auctioneers: Jon Pullin  
Bulls £435, Heifers £290

A strong consignment of fresh and weaned calves on offer that sold to a very good trade for the best Continental bulls, best heifers a strong trade the medium and smaller sorts again a much more selective trade.

Dairy Breeds saw very best Friesians to £235 from EJ Pike & Son and £175 for RC Ponting & Son, range £15+ with an average of £51. Ayrshire Bulls sold to £90 and Dairy Shorthorn from B Gough at £300. Fleckvieh from JA Hobbs at £200.

Best Continental bulls just as dear, British Blue bulls to £410 for JR & SE Cook and two smart Simmentals from EJ Pike & Son at £435 and £428. Limousin to £408 from TT & H Barber. A superb Aberdeen Angus bull sold to £410 for KD Sheridan and £280 for P Beard. Hereford Bulls to £272.

Heifer trade more selective, best easy to sell but the lesser quality calves looked low in places. British Blue twice to £290 for Cimarron Partnership, Limousin to £270 from M/s T & H Barber. Medium heifers £130 - £170. Very best Native calves saw Alf Jones Hereford heifers at £218, same for GJ & FL Robertson. A strong consignment of mainly medium quality and dairy bred weaned calves intermixed with some first quality native sorts.

Henry Saunders consigned 3-4 month Hereford steers off the cows at £472 with Aberdeen Angus steers to the same money and his heifers made a good £330. Aberdeen Angus out of dairy cows saw £330 and heifers similarly bred to £200-£205. Ayrshire bulls generally £80 - £95.

A few more forward met a very similar trade to last week's stronger trade. Again only a few real strong, near meat sorts on offer topping at £1205 (191p/kg) for Limousin steers from Mr G Morse, Whitminster & Aberdeen Angus steers to £1182 (192p/kg) from M/s R Pert & Sons, East Challow. The stronger farming steers were again a good solid trade trading between £1000 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg) topping at £1135 (192p/kg) for Simmental steers from M/s C & C Hicks, Burghclere. The younger, stronger sorts were between £880 - £1000 (185 - 200p/kg).

The Friesian steers were also a good trade with the stronger sorts over £900 topping at £930 (157p/kg) from M/s A Webb & Son, Cleverton. Medium types were £750 - £800 (142 - 148p/kg).

The heifers saw the few stronger sorts topping at £1065 (177p/kg) for a Simmental from M/s F Nutland & Son, Minety & £1058 (174p/kg) for a Limousin from Mr G Morse, Whitminster. The stronger farming heifers were generally £850 - £940 (175 - 180p/kg).

## BCMS UPDATE

When you apply for a passport, you should receive it within 14 days. If you don't, the passport will be treated as lost and you should contact BCMS.

If BCMS have issued the passport and you haven't received it, they will carry out checks and may send you a replacement free of charge if you have informed them within 6 weeks.

From 1 October 2018, if you do not inform BCMS within 6 weeks of the date the passport was produced, you will have to pay a fee of £20 per animal when you apply for the replacement passport.

You should also tell BCMS if you've sent in a passport for any reason and you've not received it back within 14 days.

A mixed show of lambs with more meat around but more of the lesser breeds & looser coated sorts today. Trade has struggled all week but probably better than some were expecting. The few very best lambs topped at 198p/kg £85 for 43kg from Mr R Richins. The general better shaped, good meat lambs traded between 170 – 1180p/kg with the fair meat but looser coated sorts were 160 – 168p/kg. The few heavier lambs sold mostly between £75 - £80 topping at £90 twice from M/s R & B Kimber.

Today saw the Annual Cirencester Sheep Fair with a good entry in all sections. **677 STORE LAMBS:** A good entry saw the stronger framed sorts mostly between £66 - £68. Mediums farming lambs were £54 - £58 & smaller sorts £40 - £48. Ewe lambs topped at £100 for Texel's from Mr T Prew.

**960 BREEDING EWES & THEAVES:** The sale includes 2 genuine dispersal sales with strong 4 year old North Country Mules to £80 (3 times), £78 (twice) with the 5 years to £80 & £75 from M/s R & J Drew. Suffolk x Mule ewes (Flock ages) were £85 & North Country Mule theaves from the same home were £92 & £90. North Country Mules theaves sold to £102 (3 times) from Mr A Jefferies & £98 from M/s H & S Rogers. Lleyn x Theaves sold to £100 from M/s Pusey Farming.

Trade was less but better than many centres No real strong ewes on offer with the stronger half meat Continental & Suffolk ewes trading between £70 - £76 & Mules £50 - £60. The medium half meat ewes were £48 - £55 & smaller sorts £85 - £45. Leaner grazing types were out in abundance and look a good buy if you have some grass between £20 - £30. Rams to £95.

Steers 151p/kg, Heifers 176p/kg, Cows 114p/kg

A few decent cattle forward saw Bazadaise steers & heifers topping at 195p/kg & 205p/kg respectively from M/s P & T Akers. Native breeds saw Hereford & Aberdeen Angus heifers 180 – 184p/kg. A few lesser breeds & plainer sorts 130 – 140p/kg.

Another flying trade on the cows with the few better beef cows 154 – 156p/kg topping at 157p/kg for a Bazadaise from M/s P & T Akers. The better, good meat dairy cows were 120 – 125p/kg with medium cows 115 – 120p/kg. The leaner cows 80 – 90p/kg with a few plain sorts 70 – 80p/kg.
