Better trade, more buyers present and more calves could have been sold. A few more bidding to rear Friesians today, best £102 for A G Jennings avg £43.50.

Plenty of native bred bulls selling to £278 for Aberdeen Angus from FE White & Sons and £272 for Cimarron Partnership, 10 avg £220. Hereford to £235 for Alf Jones, Lawmaker sired calf, we sell his 40 head Friesian herd here next Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> February, the majority in calf to that good bull.

Medium British Blue bulls sold to £300 for NJ Gosling, Simmental to £290 for EJ Pike & Son.

Heifers also sold better, Blonde's to £240 for DE Meredith and British Blue's to £225 for JD Wright & Son. Best Simmental's to a top of £285 from EJ Pike & Son, £250 for RJ & TJ Andrews.

A smart bunch of weaned Hereford bulls from NJ Gosling sold to £335 his two Hereford heifers of the same age made a solid £260.

Avg: Steers £865 (188p/kg), Heifers £738 (155p/kg)

Another pleasing entry with some good hardy cattle on offer but not much strength on offer today. Trade was extremely good especially for what was on offer and again dearer than many other local centres.

The few stronger farming Continental steers a very good trade between £1080 - £1100 (180 - 195p/kg) topping at £1290 (185p/kg) & £1150 (201p/kg) for Charolais steers from Mr S Coates, Haresfield. The good well-bred Continental steers were £950 - £1050 (190 - 210p/kg) topping at £1085 (204p/kg) for Charolais' from Mr T Greves, Leaffield. The younger steers were also well sold between £750 - £900 (185 - 210p/kg).

Another good show of farming native breeds also met a stronger trade with a top of £1100 (189p/kg) for Hereford steers from Mr S Pinner, Andover with Aberdeen Angus from M/s R & R Boulton, Brinkworth to £1010 (183p/kg). The farming sorts were £880 - £980 (180 - 195p/kg).

A few Friesian steers saw a top of £700 (129p/kg) from M/s K & W Kingston, Wickwar with youngsters sorts £530 - £645 (125 - 135p/kg).

The Continental heifers saw a few near meat sorts trading between £1060 - £1100 topping at £1162 (184p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s F Nutland & Son, Minety. The stronger farming heifers were dearer between £900 - £1000 (170 - 180p/kg) with the younger sorts £700 - £750 (175 - 185p/kg). The native breeds saw a top of £1100 (173p/kg) & £1022 (173p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from M/s K & A Godwin, North Wraxall. The general stronger sorts were £770 - £850 (160 - 170p/kg).

Not too many weaned calves forward with mixed quality but a strong trade for what was on offer. Aberdeen Angus steers (9 - 10mths) sold to £602 (191p/kg) from Mr C White, Newent. Blonde steers (11mths) sold to £695 (170p/kg) from M/s D & H Smith, Saul.

Numbers shorter everywhere this week as farmers with hoggetts starting to run out & the feeding men not ready to take the price. Another entry of mostly heavier hoggetts which have seen a more difficult trade all week.

The handyweight hoggetts saw the better export types 195 - 200p/kg topping at 203p/kg £70 for 34½kg from Mr A Grindle. The general handyweights were well sold in comparison between 185 - 190p/kg.

The medium weight 45 - 48kg hoggetts are the most difficult to sell (this applies in all markets & deadweight) and today not helped by most of these being loose coated or Mule x types trading between £77 - £80. The meated heavier hogs were dearer than anywhere this week and a similar trade to last week between £88 - £90.
