A short entry with lacked much quality but sold to an extremely dear trade and one of the dearest ever for what was on offer.

The stronger farming short term steers were a very good trade topping at £1200 (191p/kg) for Simmental's from M/s C & C Hicks, Burghclere & £1175 (188p/kg) for a Limousin steer from M/s W & M Gash, Leigh. The stronger native breeds saw a top of £1145 (214p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from M/s Bybrook Farm, Stanton St Quinton.

The medium term, farming steers traded between £925 - £1000 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1005 (237p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s R Simpkins & Partners, Luckington.

A very good Friesian trade with the stronger farming types £830 - £850 topping (160 - 170p/kg) topping at £938 (168p/kg) from Mr L Coleman, Andoversford. The medium sorts seemed extremely dear between £720 - £750 (155 - 165p/kg) with the lesser types £460 - £500 (140 - 150p/kg).

Not much strength in the heifer section with a top of £1098 (202p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from M/s Bybrook Farm, Stanton St Quinton & £1070 (208p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s W & M Gash, Leigh. The medium term sorts were £850 - £900 (190 - 210p/kg) & younger heifers £680 - £750 (210 - 225p/kg) topping at £865 (228p/kg) & £745 (240p/kg) for Blonde's from M/s P & L Gibbs, Radford Semele.

Another good trade on a few weaned calves & young stores with young Aberdeen Angus steers (3 - 4mths) to £285 (228p/kg) from M/s K & C Gough, Marlborough with their heifers to £310 (282p/kg). Simmental heifers (6 - 11mths) to £680 (200p/kg) from Mr M Langsbury, Andoversford.

The same story everywhere this week, with more lambs to choose from buyers can now be selective. Meat & weight is what is wanted with everything else harder work. Last year we couldn't believe the trade at these levels, this year sees a few disappointed even though it's still ahead.

The good meat lambs still traded between 220 – 230p/kg topping at 236p/kg £104 for 44kg from M/s RJ & BE Kimber. The good meat lighter lambs saw a top of £84 for 38½kg from Mr D Gay. The general run of lambs which are starting to go a bit loose coated or leaner were 205 – 215p/kg with some real lean (almost stores) around 200p/kg. Only a handful of heavier lambs sold to £110 for 50kg from Mr N Farmer.

A hot week forecast will see lambs not doing so make sure they are meat for the best price.
