Best Natives saw Hereford from AW Jones at £310 and £305 with other smart Continental to £372 and £362 from MT & I Scott (Bazadaise) and £320 for a Simmental Bull from RJ & TJ Andrews. Heifers in strong demand, British Blues to £358 and £322 for JR & ED Newton, Bazadaise at £258 from MT & I Scott. Aberdeen Angus heifers to £220 for RF & LA Tarver, £205 for JD Wright & Son, 4 averaging £192.

A good, pleasing entry of mostly farming cattle with not too much strength on offer. In over 60 years of selling cattle it was probably the dearest trade Arthur White had ever seen he commented and you have to see them sold to appreciate how dear the cattle are. As in previous weeks the best stronger cattle seem the cheapest in comparison with the lesser & younger sorts just getting dearer & dearer.

The stronger farming steers met a very good trade with the better sorts traded over £1100 (195 - 220p/kg) topping at £1245 (207p/kg) for a Hereford steer from M/s J W Emmerson & Son, Coln St Aldwyns.

The mid age cattle Continental steers were again £1000 - £1100 (195 - 220p/kg) with the younger & lesser sorts £850 - £1000 (200 - 220p/kg). The farming native breed steers continue to sell exceptionally well between £1000 - £1050 (210 - 240p/kg).

The Friesian's steers were lacking in strength selling to a top of £845 (150p/kg) for overage steers from M/s J & A Livall, Highworth. The rest were all medium & lesser sorts between £450 - £700 (135 – 150p/kg).

Some good strong quality Continental heifers on offer sold extremely well trading between £1080 - £1150 (180 – 205p/kg) topping at £1190 (216p/kg) for Charolais' from M/s R & B Kimber, Christian Malford. The good farming sorts were £900 - £1000 (190 - 210p/kg). The native breeds saw a top of £995 (171p/kg) for a Hereford from M/s Shorten & Evans, Newent. with the stronger farming sorts £905 - £950 (175 – 190p/kg).

A good show of weaned calves saw mostly Aberdeen Angus on offer. Steers (10-13mnths) to £1022 (227p/kg) & £925 (205p/kg) from Mr P Cuthbert, Minsterworth, (11-13mnths) to £1078 (236p/kg) & £1070 (235p/kg) from M/s Owlpen Park Farms, Owlpen. (7-8mnths) to £735 (233p/kg) from Mr G Pothecary, Cricklade & (10-12mnths) to £932 (251p/kg) & £852 (233p/kg) from Mr T Paton, Fairford with his heifers to £710 (197p/kg).

Cracking Limousin steers (9 – 10mnths) sold to £848 (226p/kg) from M/s F & S Robins, Two Bridges.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abartoir.
