Avg: Steers £1009 (188p/kg), Heifers £860 (178p/kg)

An exceptional entry of strong quality cattle sold to a very good trade with run after run of strong steers trading over £1000. The strong, short term cattle saw Continental steers over £1200 (13 times) topping at £1285 (204p/kg) for British Blue's from M/s R & K Clark, Culkerton with Limousin steers to £1270 twice (217 & 203p/kg) from Mr T Harding, Kington. The meat heifers topped at £1150 (170p/kg) & £1135 (177p/kg) for Hereford's from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton & M/s H Farnsworth & Son, Chedworth Laines respectively.

The stronger farming cattle were extremely well sold trading between £1050 - £1150 (190 - 230p/kg) with South Devon steers topping at £1260 (233p/kg) from Mr D Partridge, Brockworth. The heifers saw many trading between £930 - £1080 (185 - 205p/kg).

The younger farming sorts were also well sold with Simmental steers (15 - 16mths) to £975 (222p/kg) & £970 (215p/kg) from M/s R & J Merrett, Slimbridge with their British Blue steers to £1060 (186p/kg). Their heifers saw British Blue's to £960 (188p/kg) & Simmental's to £885 (190p/kg).

A few Friesian steers topped at £990 (155p/kg) & £910 (149p/kg) from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton.

A strong Simmental grazing cow sold to £1230 (140p/kg) from Mr T Watson, Water Lane.

Avg: Steers £799 (174p/kg), Heifers £704 (166p/kg)

A different type of entry compared to yesterday saw more younger & second quality sorts on offer but trade exceptionally strong for what was offer.

The few stronger farming steers traded over £1100 topping at £1230 (190p/kg) for Hereford steers from M/s J Allen & Son, Olveston. The better shaped younger steers traded around £1000 topping at £1190 (172p/kg) from M/s L Irvine, Norton. The medium steers were £830 - £900 generally and seemed well sold.

A few stronger Friesian steers sold to £968 (152p/kg) & £905 (165p/kg) from M/s A Webb & Son, Cleverton. British Friesian steers sold to £945 (172p/kg) from M/s P & J Holness, Leighterton. The farming Friesian steers were £760 - £850 (138 - 160p/kg) with the smaller sorts £480 - £500 (125 - 140p/kg).

Strong, near meat heifers topped at £1178 (168p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s A Webb & Son, Cleverton with Aberdeen Angus to £1100 (170p/kg) from M/s G Denton & Family, Thatcham. The stronger farming heifers were £900 - £1000 with the medium types £750 - £880.
