Avg: Steers £773 (178p/kg), Heifers £711 (169p/kg)

A mixed show of cattle with not many stronger sorts on offer this month. Trade was remarkably good considering an easing at many other centres but not here. The few strong near meat cattle saw a top of £1360 (174p/kg) & £1285 (192p/kg) for British Blue steers from Mr A Hunt, Waterlane. The stronger farming cattle were again a very good trade between £950 - £1050 (215 - 224p/kg) topping at £1185 (224p/kg) for Limousin steers & £1170 (213p/kg) & £1128 (225p/kg) for Limousin heifers from M/s G Sealey & Son, Clapton. The younger & smaller cattle were also a fair trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (6mths) to £725 (213p/kg) from Mr B Gough, Kington Langley & Hereford steers (6 - 9mths) to £460 (209p/kg) from Mr R Prout, Frocester. A unbelievable trade on the grazing cows with meat Friesian's to £890 (148p/kg) from M/s Manor Farms, Chedworth & £1035 (157p/kg) from M/s Reading & Kirby, Langford.

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

A pleasing dairy trade for what was on offer with incalf heifers due October to £945 & £855 from Mr T S F Baker, Cricklade. A British Friesian bulling heifer to £838 from Mr A Jones, Moreton Valence.

A run of Hereford cows with Hereford steer calves (1 - 2mths) sold to £1190 & £1080 & heifer calves to £1095 & £995 again from Mr T S F Baker, Cricklade. British Friesian cows & Hereford steer calves to £770 & £745 from the same home.

Another pleasing entry saw a similar trade with the stronger & medium farming cattle as dear and the smaller sorts well sold especially for the quality on offer. The stronger, near meat steers were another very good trade over £1200 topping at £1358 (201p/kg) & £1270 (201p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from Mr R S Ford, Kington Langley & £1305 (180p/kg) for a Limousin from Mr E Gash, Leigh. The stronger farming steers were a good trade between £1030 - £1100 (195 - 210p/kg) topping at £1122 (224p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from M/s R & B Kingston & Sons, Wickwar. The medium term, farming steers saw the better sorts £850 - £950 (190 - 220p/kg) & the longer term £750 - £850 (200 - 220p/kg).

Very few Friesian steers saw a top of £800 (168p/kg) from M/s R & B Kingston & Sons, Tresham.

Not many stronger, short term farming heifers on offer trading around £1000 topping at £1090 (187p/kg) for a British Blue from Mr E Gash, Leigh. The stronger farming heifers were again a good trade between £850 - £950 (190 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £800 - £880 (180 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

A very mixed show of weaned calves met another good trade with British Blue steers (9 - 11mths) to £695 (283p/kg) from M/s R & K Clark, Culkerton. Aberdeen Angus steers (11mths) to £690 (209p/kg) from M/s F G Smith & Sons, Norton & £715 (220p/kg) from Mr D Rugman, Oldbury Naite. Smart British Blue steers (7 - 8mths) sold to £778 (225p/kg) from m/s M & L Robertson, Horton.

A strong entry of calves with limited quality but again plenty of buyers for all types of calves. 15 Friesian calves sold to £165 and £120 from RT & EB Townsend averaging £60. The native trade remains good with Hereford bulls to £285 from RJ & TJ Andrews and Aberdeen Angus to £220 from R & R Baker Ltd. A run of Hereford x Jersey bulls and heifers sold £100 - £165 for bulls and £80 - £125 for heifers generally. First quality British Blue bulls from JR & SE Cook sold to £500 and £485 with their heifers to £335. £255 for a smart British Blue from DH & DR Smart. Aberdeen Angus heifers to £170 for R & R Baker Ltd. Simmental heifers sold to £212 from RT & EB Townsend. A run of weaned calves forward saw 18 Friesian bulls top at £260 for PJ & SR Bennett, £235 for J Dowler. Some weaned British Blues form the same home sold exceptionally well to £438 and £400 with weaned British Blue heifers also at £352 - £400.
