88 REARING CALVES

Bulls £365, Heifers £232

An equal share of weaned and fresh calves on offer but generally a very limited amount of first quality sorts available but those forward were well sold for type. Best British Blue bulls to £365 for BA Marsh Farming all other continental bulls of medium quality to £300. Hereford to £300 for RJ & TJ Andrews. A superb Fleckvieh bull from Jess Vaughan made £260, a good Friesian from RJ & TJ Andrews at £145. Other Friesians £30 - £70.

Heifers sold to £232 for a British Blue from TT & H Barber, Hereford to £210 for AR & M Highman, all others mediums £120 - £150. Weaned in big numbers but only a few quality sorts, British Blue steers to £375 from Whistledown Farms, Aberdeen Angus from the same home to £350, heifers of medium quality sold very well for type £240 - £360.

Steers Avg £797 (183p/kg), Heifers Avg £719 (176p/kg)

A few more forward but not of the quality & strength of last week. Trade was still remarkably good but maybe a shade easier than last week but due mostly to the quality.

The few stronger farming steers were again well sold trading between £1070 - £1120 (180 - 190p/kg) topping at £1160 (203p/kg) for a Simmental from M/s D & H Smith, Saul. The younger farming steers were £900 - £1000 (185 - 215p/kg) with Aberdeen Angus to £1068 (190p/kg) & £1065 (199p/kg) from M/s B J Arkell & Partner, Whelford & M/s R & B Kingston & Sons, Wotton under Edge respectively.

The dairy bred steers & medium types seemed a good trade selling between £830 - £925 (180 - 190p/kg) with the younger sorts £580 - £750 (170 - 185p/kg).

Only a few Friesian steers on offer with the stronger sorts topping at £908 (150p/kg) from M/s P & J Holness, Leighterton. The farming sorts were £690 - £780 (145 - 152p/kg).

The heifers met another good trade with the stronger farming types around £1000 (180 - 190p/kg) topping at £1080 (194p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s M & S Dyer, Hambrook. The younger farming heifers were generally £850 - £950 (180 - 190p/kg). The dairy bred & medium sorts were £650 - £750 (170 - 180p/kg).

A good trade on the weaned calves with British Blue steers (6mths) to £540 (291p/kg) & British Blue heifers £425 (242p/kg) from Mr C White, Newent.

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (tb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home. The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

The good commercial lambs traded between 185 – 190p/kg. The heavier hogs were also dearer trading generally over £90 and the best over £100 topping at £102 for 53½kg from M/s S & E Ractliffe.
