Bulls £415, Heifers £172

A very tough trade on all but the best and the 2nd/3rd quality calves very difficult to sell. The day had a few highlights with British Blue bulls to £415 for CR Slade and a very good Montbelliarde from DH & DR Smart made £390. Best Aberdeen Angus to £328 for Perry Beard, most other bull calves £80-£150 and looking very good value. Only 10 heifers on offer selling to £172 for Blonde form DE Meredith.

Aberdeen Angus weaned steers to £295 and Devon's to £252. A tidy Longhorn heifer sold to £300 for Harrow Farms.

Friesian heifers to £665 (114p/kg) from Mr A Ractliffe, Harescombe. Young cows & heifers from M/s S & H Freeth, Slaughterford saw Aberdeen Angus to £462 (88p/kg) & Friesian's to £498 (100p/kg) & £415 (78p/kg).

A similar number forward met as equally as good a trade as last week especially considering the quality on offer this week was not as good generally.

The stronger Continental farming short term steers met another good solid trade between £1040 - £1100 (170 - 190p/kg) topping at £1148 (190p/kg) & £1078 (182p/kg) for Charolais steers from Mr G Beale, Leighterton. The better bred younger & stronger farming steers were again a good solid trade trading between £900 - £1000 (170 - 190p/kg). The younger sorts were between £770 - £870 (175 - 200p/kg). The second & third quality sorts were in shorter supply and a similar trade to last week.

The native breeds saw the stronger sorts topping at £1128 (180p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus steer from M/s Grafton Farms, Beckford & £1100 (174p/kg) from Mr G Mayo, Brimscombe. The farming sorts were £700 - £900 (170 - 180p/kg).

The Friesian steers were in short supply with the stronger sorts topping at £950 (141p/kg) from Mr A Smith, Badminton. The medium sorts were £450 - £500 (90 - 115p/kg) generally.

The heifers met a good trade with the few stronger near meat sorts trading between £960 - £1020 (170 - 180p/kg) topping at £1052 (183p/kg) for Charolais' from Mr G Beale, Leighterton. The stronger native heifers topped at £1008 (169p/kg) from Mr N Smith, Stanton St Quinton. The stronger farming heifers were generally £800 - £900 (155 - 170p/kg). The medium types £650 - £750 (150 - 165p/kg) & lesser sorts £500 - £600 (120 - 140p/kg).

A few good weaned calves saw shapely British Blue steers (5 - 7mths) to £710 (236p/kg) from Mrs M Folwell, Aldermaston. Saler & Charolais x steers (10 - 11mths) sold to £795 (173p/kg) & £745 (192p/kg) from M/s W Parrott & Son, Uffington with their heifers to £635 (172p/kg).

A shorter entry as most centres this week which has resulted in the trade increasing as the week has progressed. Trade remains very similar to last week with the few better bred meat lambs trading between were 175 – 179p/kg topping at 182p/kg £71 for 39kg from Mr T Sammons. The general, good meat lambs traded between 170 – 175p/kg with looser coated & lesser breed sorts were 162 – 165p/kg. The few heavier lambs sold mostly between £78 - £80 topping at £84.50 (twice) from M/s C & J Phillips.
