Avg: Steers £736 (167p/kg), Heifers £671 (155p/kg)

A large entry of mainly stronger farming cattle with many showing the weather conditions and coming in on the plainer side. Trade was firm throughout on the better bred sorts as at an unrestricted sale but the lesser sorts harder to place.

Very little meat on offer with the few topping at 1292 (173p/kg) for Hereford steers from M/s N Pearson & Son, Bledington. The meat heifers saw a top of £1102 (192p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s H P Nicholas & Son, High Woolaston.

The stronger farming cattle were a good, firm trade with steers £980 - £1080 (185 - 200p/kg) topping at £1100 (208p/kg) for a Blonde steer from M/s S Horton & Sons, Poulton. The heifers were £850 - £1000 (160 - 175p/kg) topping at £1088 (188p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from M/s R & W Whatley, Badbury.

The younger steers sold to a similar trade between £800 - £900 (180 - 200p/kg) with heifers £700 - £800 (160 - 175p/kg).

The lesser shaped cattle or out of spec sorts are difficult to place except at lower figures generally between £450 - £600 (120 - 140p/kg).

A handful of weaned calves sold to a surprisingly good trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (4 - 5mths) to £242 from Adames (Flansham) Ltd, Bognor Regis. A good show of mostly meat grazing cows saw Friesian's to £970 (140p/kg) & £745 (111p/kg) from M/s Hartpury College with Hereford's to £1060 (120p/kg) from M/s Reading & Kirby, Langford.

Avg: Steers £816 (177p/kg), Heifers £609 (158p/kg)

A similar entry met a very similar trade to last week's strong trade with the same story everywhere the stronger and better bred cattle a good trade but the second & third quality sorts extremely difficult to sell.

Again only a few real strong, near meat sorts on offer topping at £1180 (172p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus steer from M/s R Pert & Sons, East Challow.

The stronger farming steers were again a good solid trade trading between £980 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg) topping at £1100 (180p/kg) for Simmental steers from Mr R Saunders, Garsdon & £1085 (194p/kg) from M/s G Gardner & Son, St Catherines. The younger, stronger sorts were between £880 - £950 (185 - 200p/kg). The lesser bred & plainer steers were £590 - £700 (150 - 165p/kg).

The Friesian steers are generally a harder trade with the few medium sorts to £590 (122p/kg) from M/s R Simpkins & Partners, Luckington.

The heifers saw the few stronger sorts topping at £995 (191p/kg) for a Charolais from Mr M E Bennett, Thornbury. The stronger farming heifers were generally £770 - £880 (175 - 180p/kg) & the lesser types £500 - £650 (140 - 150p/kg).

A decent weaned calf trade for the better sorts with Hereford steers (7 - 8mths) to £585 (195p/kg) & £520 (221p/kg) from Mr T Grundy, Bromsberrow. British Blue steers to £592 (185p/kg) from Mrs R Newman, Redmarley.

## BCMS UPDATE

When you apply for a passport, you should receive it within 14 days. If you don't, the passport will be treated as lost and you should contact BCMS.

If BCMS have issued the passport and you haven't received it, they will carry out checks and may send you a replacement free of charge if you have informed them within 6 weeks.

From 1 October 2018, if you do not inform BCMS within 6 weeks of the date the passport was produced, you will have to pay a fee of £20 per animal when you apply for the replacement passport. You should also tell BCMS if you've sent in a passport for any reason and you've not received it back within 14 days.

A good entry of calves again met a ring packed with buyers who again were very prepared to give top money for the best, but the middle types difficult to place.

Dairy breeds of 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> quality today topping at £55 averaging £27. One superb dairy Shorthorn from B Gough & Sons made £275. The Continental trade saw best British Blue bulls to £452 from JR & ED Newton but many medium and small sorts put that average at £205. Charolais sold to £350 for HJ Saunders, Simmental to £445 for B Gough & Sons and £395 for RJ & TJ Andrews.

Hereford and Aberdeen Angus sold well, Angus to £455 and £405 for R Beard & Son (avg £348) and Hereford to £455 and £448 (avg £335) for RJ & TJ Andrews. Heifer trade again selective, Blonde to £200, British Blues to £298 for L Lewis.
