Another very good entry of mostly medium & younger farming cattle with not too much strength on offer. Trade was exceptionally strong on all sorts and again probably a shade dearer on the week.

The stronger, short term farming steers traded over £1200 (195 - 210p/kg) topping at £1245 (202p/kg) for a Charolais steer from M/s D & M Manners, Tockenham. The medium term, stronger farming steers saw the better sorts £1080 - £1150 (190 - 220p/kg) topping at £1215 (209p/kg) for British Blue steers from Mr A W Goscombe, Hillesley. The general stronger steers were £1000 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg).

The younger & medium steers were again well sold between £850 - £950 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1000 (204p/kg) for a 12 month old Hereford steer from M/s B Gough & Sons, Braydon.

The Friesian steers saw a top of £1160 (156p/kg) for average steers from M/s P & R Jenner, Cirencester with the stronger sorts generally £860 - £950 (154 - 160p/kg). The medium steers were £710 - £850 (150 - 170p/kg) with a few younger sorts £510 - £600 (130 - 145p/kg).

The stronger, short term farming heifers were around £1100 topping at £1288 (238p/kg) for very showy British Blue from Mr D Hillman, Rodbourne.

The stronger farming heifers were again a very good trade between £900 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £800 - £900 (190 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg). The native heifers were in strong demand with a top of £1110 (200p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s Bybrook Farms, Lower Stanton St Quinton with most of the stronger sorts £950 - £1050.

The weaned calves saw a wonderful run of Simmental's (9 - 12mths) from M/s Top Farms, Aston Somerville saw the steers to £945 (242p/kg) & £858 (268p/kg) & the heifers £812 (253p/kg) & £800 (225p/kg).

Limousin steers (10 - 13mths) sold to £860 (252p/kg) from M/s T Limbrick & Son, Sherborne & Aberdeen Angus steers (5 - 8mths) to £680 (247p/kg) & £480 (266p/kg) from M/s R Handley & Son, Cambridge & (10mths) to £750 (211p/kg) from M/s Brockhill Farm Stud, Naunton.

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are NO LONGER ALLOWED to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

The good meat hoggetts were a good trade between 245 - 250p/kg topping at 256p/kg twice £100 for 39kg & £110 for 43kg both from Mr A Grindle. The general run of meat hogs were 235 - 240p/kg. The leaner & lesser sorts were well sold between 215 - 230p/kg dependent on breed.

The heavier hoggetts again saw the meat well sold with the very best topping at £140 for 58½kg from Mr M Hobbs. The general run were £115 - £120 with the leaner or lesser breeds £100 - £110. A few sheep pushing teeth were generally £90 for the stronger sorts.
