A very strong entry of calves sold to a good trade considering the weather. 28 mixed Friesian bulls averaged a good £75 topping at £185 from M/s R & T Andrews. A few different faces looking to purchase rearing calves with the better Continental bulls to £390 twice for a British Blue from M/s R Ponting & Son & a Simmental from Mr M Pike. Medium bull calves were £200 - £250 generally with a few lesser sorts £120 - £160.

Not many top heifers on offer topping at £258 for a Bazadaise from M/s M & I Scott & Son with the mediums £160 - £190.

A decent entry with a few customers looking for cattle but the lack of grass & dropping finished prices now taking effect.

A few stronger farming cattle on offer trading around the £1000 with steers to £1130 (171p/kg) for a Limousin steer from M/s A & P Mason, Ablington & heifers to £1100 (162p/kg) for a Simmental from M/s H C Jones & Son. The medium term farming steers were £750 - £880 (180 - 185p/kg) & heifers generally £670 - £800 (165 - 175p/kg). Again the lesser cattle were the hardest to sell between £300 - £400 generally.

A few better Friesian steers on offer met a good trade with stronger sorts £750 - £820 (135 - 145p/kg) topping at £860 (148p/kg) from M/s S Poultney & Son, Frocester.

A few weaned calves & younger stores saw British Blue steers (7 - 1mths) to £482 (210p/kg) from Ms J Hobbs, Elmore. A run of Limousin's (8 - 10mths) saw steers to £612 (175p/kg) & heifers £570 (168p/kg) from M/s Cadenham Farms, Foxham.

A few more forward but most vendors unless feeding lambs are struggling for meat. Trade was similar to last week and the few better good meat lambs traded between 180 – 190p/kg topping at 200p/kg £850 for 42½kg from Mr R Richins. The fair meat but looser coated sorts were 173 – 178p/kg £73 - £78 with the lesser sorts 150 – 160p/kg and worth as much in the stores.
