Avg: Steers £882 (174p/kg), Heifers £720 (151p/kg)

A good entry sold to a good solid trade. The entry saw some good medium term stronger farming cattle which traded between £1050 - £1150 (180 - 200p/kg) to a top of £1195 (171p/kg), £1135 (183p/kg) & £1055 (165p/kg) for Montbelliarde & Swedish Red steers from M/s P & J Holness, Leighterton. A grand run of farming British Blue steers from M/s G Gardner & Son, St Catherines sold to £1170 (195p/kg), £1150 (198p/kg) & £1145 (194p/kg) with their Hereford steers to £1142 (194p/kg). The better bred younger farming steers (15 - 18mths) were £950 - £1050 (190 - 210p/kg) with the second quality £650 - £750 (180 - 200p/kg).

The heifers saw a top of £1160 (163p/kg) for an overage Simmental from M/s T & V Bennett, Ampney St Mary with Friesian heifers to £1045 (177p/kg) & £892 (142p/kg) from M/s J & D Pullin, Leonard Stanley.

A good show of grazing cows saw the strong meat sorts to £1170 (146p/kg) for a Hereford from Mr C Rouse, Bampton £1165 (132p/kg) from Mrs D Smith & Sons, Stroud. Medium grazing cows were £700 - £850 (120 - 140p/kg) with the plainer sorts £550 - £700 (110 - 120p/kg)

Avg: Steers £881 (207p/kg), Heifers £799 (212p/kg)

A marvellous entry for the time of year and some cattle were as dear as you have ever seen or will ever see.

A grand run of 156 cattle from Mr T Gaden, Stow on the Wold saw some superb farming cattle with a ringful of buyers in attendance for them. The stronger Continental steers were £1100 - £1180 (205 - 210p/kg) topping at £1218 (206p/kg) & £1175 (200p/kg) for Charolais steers. The medium term farming steers were £980 - £1050 (220 - 250p/kg) with the younger sorts extremely dear £740 - £950 (240 - 286p/kg). His Aberdeen Angus steers topped the day at £1275 (212p/kg) & Hereford steers to £1098 (196p/kg) & £992 (200p/kg).

The Continental heifers were as dear as ever with the stronger farming sorts £1040 - £1070 (200 - 205p/kg). The medium term sorts saw bunch after bunch £900 - £980 (215 - 235p/kg) with the younger sorts (7 - 12mths) up some £100 - £200 a head on the week £780 - £930 (235 - 281p/kg)

The other entries saw strong Limousin steers to £1280 (196p/kg) from M/s A & W Hancock, Slad with their Charolais & Limousin heifers to £1135 (195p/kg) & £1065 (213p/kg). Good farming Charolais steers from Mr G Beale, Leighterton sold to £1190 (205p/kg) & £1120 (217p/kg) with his heifers to £1078 (211p/kg) & £1072 (190p/kg). Hereford steers from M/s R & V Tobin, Awre sold to £1105 (190p/kg) with Limousin heifers to £958 (190p/kg) from the same home.

The younger farming cattle saw British Blue steers (13 - 15mths) to £788 (225p/kg) from M/s Burcher, Son & Jones, Arlingham and Aberdeen Angus steers (14 - 16mths) to £968 (225p/kg) from Mr C Goodman, Braydon.

A few strong Friesian steers topped at £860 (142p/kg) from M/s R & R Boulton, Brinkworth. Charolais grazing cows sold to £1130 (143p/kg) from M/s N Starr, Cleverton.

Smart Continentals saw British Blues to £440 from B Gough & Sons topping at £445 from JA Hobbs. Simmentals to £300. The hot weather saw hay making taking priority nearly everywhere this week with lambs shading instead of eating so not doing and going back. People doing the same and not many hot roast lamb dinners being eaten. Abattoirs reporting very little demand home or abroad. Politely I would describe the entry as not the best quality with the weather taking a big effect now.

The few good meat lambs traded around the 200p/kg topping at 208p/kg £80 for 38½kg from M/s J Jenkins & Sons. The fair meat but looser coated sorts were 185 - 195p/kg with the leaner sorts 170 - 180p/kg.
