Avg: Steers £1991 (184p/kg), Heifers £834 (171p/kg)

Another very good trade on a good show of mostly stronger or good farming cattle.

The stronger near meat steers & heifers traded between £1200 - £1300 topping at £1408 (170p/kg) & £1392 (193p/kg) for Simmental & British Blue steers from Mr A Hunt, Oakridge.

The stronger farming cattle seemed exceptionally well sold with the better steers £1060 - £1150 (185 - 200p/kg) with a run of British Blue steers to £1215 (203p/kg), £1200 (190p/kg) & £1190 (195p/kg) from M/s G Gardner & Son, St Catherines.

The stronger farming heifers saw Saler's from Mr M Green, Shellingford to £1088 (173p/kg), £1040 (3 times, 187p/kg, 186p/kg & 180p/kg)

Very few younger farming steers on offer selling well between £850 - £1000 (180 - 200p/kg) with the heifers £670 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

The stronger Friesian steers sold between £885 - £950 (153 - 158p/kg) topping at £995 (175p/kg) from M/s A Webb & Son, Cleverton.

A very good trade on the grazing cows saw a strong Saler cows to £1090 (132p/kg) from Mr M Green, Shellingford.

**Please note:** Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

Avg: Steers £837 (204p/kg), Heifers £800 (188p/kg)

A decent entry sold to yet another extremely good trade on all types with some cattle probably a shade dearer.

Not many stronger, short term near meat on offer with the better shaped, stronger farming steers traded over £1050 topping at £1150 (225p/kg) for Limousin steer from M/s D Rumming & Son, Lydiard Tregoze.

The general farming steers again traded between £900 - £1050 (185 - 210p/kg) & the younger farming cattle were also extremely well sold between £840 - £950 (190 - 220p/kg) with British Blue steers (18mnths) to £1015 (220p/kg) from M/s Burcher, Son & Jones, Arlingham & £1012 (208p/kg) from M/s J A Jones & Son, Cricklade.

The Friesian steers saw the stronger farming sorts trading between £770 - £800 (160 - 170p/kg) with the medium types £600 - £700 (150 - 160p/kg).

The heifers met a good trade with the stronger farming heifers very well sold trading between £1000 - £1060 (190 - 210p/kg) topping at £1100 (209p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s A & A Slatter, Toddington. The general farming Continental heifers were £860 - £950 (175 - 190p/kg). A good show of native breeds topping at £965 (170p/kg) for Hereford heifers from the same home.

The younger stores & weaned calves were again very dear with Hereford steers (9 - 11mnths) to £920 (200p/kg) & £820 (215p/kg) from M/s R & R James, Brinkworth. Hereford heifers (5 - 6mnths) to £482 (200p/kg) from M/s G Maidment & Son, Cleverton. Simmental steers (8mnths) sold to £582 (277p/kg) & £512 (227p/kg) from M/s J Emmerson & Son, Coln St Aldwyns.

Heifer trade in parallel with last week, Continentals to £250 for British Blue from RF & LA Tarver, £248 from RD Horton & Son, Aberdeen Angus and Hereford trade good £190 for AR Highman & Son & £242 from BA Marsh Farming. Simmentals from Richard Andrews at £255. Weaned British Blues to £400 for steers £405 for heifers from J Legge, Lydney.
