### 236 TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £684 (155p/kg), Heifers £636 (140p/kg)

A mixed entry with not too many strong cattle on offer met a fair trade with trade having eased at all centres this last week.

The stronger farming steers traded between £950 - £1100 topping at £1240 (163p/kg) for Blonde steer from Mr A Hunt, Waterlane. The general well grown farming steers traded at similar levels to unrestricted between £800 - £900 (170 - 180p/kg) & the younger sorts £650 - £750 (155 - 170p/kg). The lesser shaped sorts or small for age were harder to place as in the unrestricted sales with buyers able to be selective trading between £550 - £600.

Mostly medium & smaller Friesian steers on offer topping at £590 (126p/kg) from M/s S Withers & Son, Malmesbury.

The stronger farming heifers traded between £900 - £1000 topping at £1018 (174p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from M/s A Cole & Son, Easton Hastings. The general farming types traded between £700 - £850 (160 - 170p/kg).

A handful of grazing cows sold well with a top of £1100 for a Hereford & £1025 for a Shorthorn from M/s D Smith & Sons, Stroud.

A Longhorn cow & her Shorthorn steer calf sold to £700 from M/s F & J King, Whiteshill. Simmental grazing cows sold to £1080 from Mr D Gobey, Uplands. Some good stock bulls on offer with a pedigree Limousin to £1520 from Mr E Gash, Leigh with Simmentals to £1160 & £1100 from M/s E Amesbury Farms, Leckhampstead & Mr B Hillman, Rodbourne respectively.

### 271 STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £711 (163p/kg), Heifers £588 (158p/kg)

A pleasing entry for the time of year with some good farming cattle on offer sold to a good, firm trade but the edge just off and the lesser sorts. The stronger farming steers still seem well sold trading mostly between £1020 - £1100 (165 - 175p/kg) topping at £1170 (174p/kg) for a South Devon from M/s L B Cook & Family, Bisley with their Hereford's to £1122 (165p/kg). The general better bred farming steers traded between £900 - £1000 (170 - 180p/kg) with the younger sorts £800 - £850 (175 - 200p/kg). The cattle showing signs of the weather, lesser bred or small for age saw an easier trade between £650 - £750 (150 - 160p/kg).

A large percentage of Friesian steers of mostly medium or small types and many lacking much shape or finish. The few stronger sorts saw a top of £708 (143p/kg) from M/s C T Poultney & Sons, Dursley. Mediums were generally £550 - £600 (128 - 135p/kg) with the lesser sorts £470 - £525 (115 - 125p/kg).

The few stronger heifers traded between £900 - £930 (160 - 170p/kg) with the general farming sorts £700 - £800 (160 - 175p/kg).

A few weaned calves sold to a good trade with a grand run of Limousin & British Blue steers (8 - 9mths) to £905 (205p/kg), £850 (190p/kg) & £840 (200p/kg) from M/s M & H Gill, The Knapp. Aberdeen Angus steers (8 - 10mths) sold to £758 (216p/kg) & £670 (223p/kg) from Mr P Joseph, Horpit & (7 - 8mths) to £725 (201p/kg) & £620 (200p/kg) from M/s Marsden Estate Partnership, Rendcomb.

Another pleasing entry of beef cattle met a good trade but generally not the quality of last week. The better sorts were in short supply and topped at 209p/kg for a 610kg Bazadaise steer from M/s P & T Akers. The general good meated sorts were 180 - 195p/kg with the leaner or general sorts 160 - 170p/kg. A few mixed rare breeds & lesser sort dragged the averages back between 148 - 160p/kg.

33 cows on offer sold to a good trade. Very few good beef cows on offer with grand Charolais from M/s R J & B Kimber topping at 169p/kg £1398. The medium beef cows were 115 - 130p/kg with leaner or over fat types 90 - 100p/kg.

The dairy cows saw the better meat to 139p/kg & 138p/kg from M/s Burcher, Son & Jones with the leaner types 90 - 105p/kg & plain cows 68 - 85p/kg.
