A short entry met probably one of the best trades of the season with reports from other centres of the trade easing but not the case today.

The short term farming steers met a very good trade trading over £1100 (195 - 210p/kg) topping at £1248 (211p/kg), £1145 (200p/kg) & £1140 (211p/kg) for British Blue steers from M/s G Gardner & Son, St Catherines. The stronger farming cattle traded between £1000 - £1100 (200 - 210p/kg) to a top of £1095 (210p/kg) for British Blue steers from the same home & £1085 (210p/kg) from M/s Lodge Farms, Brinkworth.

The younger farming cattle (12 - 15mths) saw the better sorts £800 - £880 (210 - 220p/kg) topping at £900 (222p/kg) for a Limousin steer (14mths) from M/s T & A Rawlings, Purton Stoke.

The stronger Friesian steers met a good trade trading between £840 - £1000 (142 - 168p/kg) topping at £1012 (163p/kg) from M/s Lodge Farms, Brinkworth.

The stronger short term heifers traded between £950 - £980 topping at £1002 (178p/kg) for Hereford heifers again from M/s Lodge Farms, Brinkworth. The stronger, farming sorts were £830 - £930 (190 - 200p/kg) with the younger & lesser sorts £600 - £770.

A handful of grazing cows saw British Blue's to £1035 (127p/kg) from M/s J Jones & Son, Cricklade with Hereford's to £1090 (133p/kg) & £1055 (132p/kg) from Mrs J Webb, Spirthill. A pedigree Shorthorn bull (18mths) sold to £1200 from A J Park, Charlton.

Very few strong ewes and again a large percentage of very plain sorts on offer with the better Suffolk & Continental ewes trading between £70 - £85 and well sold for size with the half meated & smaller meat ewes traded between £65 - £75. Stronger Mules were £62 - £68. The leaner grazing ewes seemed well sold between £40 - £50 with extremely plain £25 - £40 generally. Rams to £100.
