144 TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE

2.00 pm – Auctioneer: Chris Voyce

Avg: Steers £1037 (187p/kg), Heifers £870 (155p/kg)

A very good trade on a good show of mostly stronger or good farming cattle.

The stronger near meat steers & heifers traded over £1200 (9 times) topping at £1295 (209p/kg), £1260 (180p/kg), £1238 (203p/kg) & £1228 (183p/kg) for Saler steers from Mr M Green, Shellingford with his heifers to £1270 (174p/kg). Simmental steers to £1290 (180p/kg) from Mr A Hunt, Waterlane with his British Blue's to £1230 (190p/kg).

The stronger farming cattle seemed exceptionally well sold with the better steers £1050 - £1150 (185 – 200p/kg) with Aberdeen Angus steers to £1190 (186p/kg) from M/s Mile Elm Farming, Calne. The younger farming cattle were also extremely well sold with Limousin steers to £938 (208p/kg) & £840 (200p/kg) from Mr F C Turner, Arlingham & Aberdeen Angus steers to £988 (225p/kg) & £855 (197p/kg) from M/s R & B Kingston & Sons, Tresham. The general farming heifers were £800 - £900 (155 – 175p/kg).

A few stronger Friesian steers sold to £988 (157p/kg) & £830 (150p/kg) from M/s Mile Elm Farming, Calne.

A very good trade on the grazing cows saw a strong Hereford to £1135 (132p/kg) from Mr C Rouse, Bampton with Aberdeen Angus to £885 (116p/kg) from M/s R Handley & Son, Cambridge. Friesian cows sold to £892 (126p/kg) & £830 (115p/kg) from Mr R Merrett, Arlingham with Friesian heifers to £968 (144p/kg) & £910 (121p/kg) from Mr P Baker, Leigh & £662 (130p/kg) from M/s H & S Rogers, Avon.

154 STORE CATTLE

11.30 am - Auctioneer: Jon Pullin Avg: Steers £897 (184p/kg), Heifers £734 (174p/kg)

A reasonable entry for the 5^{th} Tuesday in January sold to another very good trade but too much strength on offer.

The few stronger well grown farming steers traded over £1100 (170 – 185p/kg) topping at £1192 (180p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus steer & £1172 (180p/kg) for a Charolais from M/s L B Cook & Family, Bisley. The general stronger steers were £930 - £1050 (180 – 200p/kg) with the younger farming types seeming well sold between £750 - £900 (190 – 205p/kg).

Only a few farming Friesian steers on offer topping at £775 (159p/kg) & £722 (155p/kg) from M/s C Poultney & Sons, Dursley.

The heifers were also a good trade with the few stronger short term Continental sorts trading around £1000 topping at £1070 (172p/kg) & £1035 (160p/kg) for Blonde's from M/s D & H Smith, Saul. The native heifers were a good trade with the stronger sorts £900 - £970 (170 – 175p/kg). The general younger heifers traded between £680 - £740 (180 – 200p/kg)

A few younger stores & weaned calves continue to sell extremely well with Limousin steers (10mnths) to £882 (196p/kg) from M/s Monkhill Partners, Blaisdon with their heifers to £722 (190p/kg). Charolais steers (9 – 11mnths) sold to £882 (185p/kg) & £865 (201p/kg) from M/s W Parrott & Son, Uffington with their heifers to £820 (164p/kg) & £710 (161p/kg).

Licenses must be obtained from Animal Health by Monday, 19th February 2018

APPLYING FOR A LICENCE HAS NOW CHANGED

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (tb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to CSC.TBlicensing@apha.gis.gov.uk

APHA, Polwhele, Truro, Cornwall, TR4 9AD

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing
Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

A short entry that met a trade £20 - £30 firmer than last week particularly for the heifers. Only medium calves generally with British Blue bulls to £332 for JR & ED Newton and Simmental to £365 from Rawlings & Davis. Best today £320+. No quality Natives to talk about but Fleckvieh bulls sold to £245 from Cimmarion Partnership, best Friesians to £70 with Jogood rearers. Aberdeen Angus heifers to £145, Hereford to £182 for JWH Ball. A few weaned on offer saw Friesian steers to £160 and a British Blue Bull (10 months) at £460.

Auctioneer: Chris Voyce Hoggett SQQ 198.6p/kg Overall Average 197.8p/kg

An improved entry met a flying trade on all weights with many more needed to meet demand and both home & export buyers very fit for hoggetts. Some good runs of hoggetts on offer with the best shaped good meat hoggs trading over 200p/kg on 29 occasions. The handyweight hoggs saw a top of 221p/kg £85 for 38½kg from Mr S T Redman. The medium weight range topped at 227p/kg £100 for 44kg from M/s R & B Kimber. The good commercial lambs traded between 193 – 198p/kg with only a few leaner sorts under these figures but well sold between 185 – 190p/kg. The heavier hoggs were also dearer trading 18 times at £100 or over topping at £111 for 55kg from M/s P & R Clark & £110 for 62½kg from M/s D & R Williams & Son.

A much improved beef entry saw a good trade despite lower trades and falling deadweight prices elsewhere. A few smart cattle traded over 200p/kg topping at 224p/kg & 220p/kg for British Blue steers from M/s J & M Timbs. A smart Limousin heifer sold to 215p/kg from M/s E Pearce & Son. The general run of cattle were 185 - 195p/kg with a few leaner sorts 178 - 185p/kg. A run of rare & traditional breeds sold well between 172 - 178p/kg.

A few cows saw Friesian's to 138p/kg & 125p/kg from M/s J Simpkins & Partners. Plainer sorts 70 - 84p/kg.
