Fewer cows now calving and a shortage on offer today with quality also mixed and plenty of older calves on offer which are no dearer than the fresh calves. Friesians to £128 for MJ & JC Vaughan average £62. The native breeds saw Hereford to £230 from MJ & JC Vaughan and only a few Continental forward with British Blues to £320 for JD Wright & Son, Marlborough. Heifer calf trade decent with British Blue's and Simmentals to £228 - £230 from RF & LA Tarver, Hereford heifers to £220.

Weaned calf section saw Friesians top at £232 from C Lloyd with Aberdeen Angus bulls to £440 from BG & LD Rich. Aberdeen Angus heifers from same home to £332.

A good trade with an Aberdeen Angus cow & her Hereford x heifer calf to £1220 from Exors of Mr R Plaice, Calne with a Montbelliarde cow & her Hereford steer calf to £920 from the same home. Strong Simmental grazing cows sold to £955 (140p/kg) & £905 (122p/kg) from Mr S Coates, Haresfield. A Charolais bull sold to £1010 from Mr J Hankins, Minchinhampton.

Another pleasing entry saw a similar trade with some good grazing type of farming cattle on offer.

The stronger farming short term steers were a good trade between £1080 - £1180 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1290 (218p/kg) for a Limousin steer (14mths) from M/s W E & M Gash, Leigh. The medium term, farming steers saw the better sorts £950 - £1000 (190 - 220p/kg) with a run of very showy cattle from Mr R Carter, Coaley to £995 (239p/kg), £990 (220p/kg) & £885 (245p/kg). The general sorts were a sharper trade but included some good grazing cattle trading between £820 - £900 (220 - 240p/kg).

The Friesian steers saw a top of £860 (191p/kg) for a British Friesian from Mr A C Cook, Coaley. The Holstein Friesian's saw the stronger sorts £750 - £832 (145 - 155p/kg) with the medium types £570 - £650 (150 - 160p/kg).

Not too many stronger, short term farming heifers on offer with the better sorts over £1100 topping at £1150 (190p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s W E & M Gash, Leigh with Aberdeen Angus to £1120 (185p/kg) from M/s T & J Wyatt, Eastington. The stronger farming heifers were again a good trade between £900 - £1000 (190 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £800 - £880 (180 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

Not many weaned calves saw a good trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (9 - 11mths) to £680 (230p/kg) from M/s F G Smith & Sons, Norton. Longhorn x steers (11 - 12mths) to £700 (209p/kg) & £615 (201p/kg) from M/s Mowles Farms, Nailsworth.

Hereford heifers (10 - 13mths) to £752 (176p/kg) & £675 (180p/kg) from M/s C Harber & Son, Earls Croome.

APPLYING FOR A LICENCE HAS NOW CHANGED

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (tb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to CSC.TBlicensing@apha.gsi.gov.uk (available on our website)

APHA, Polwhele, Truro, Cornwall, TR4 9AD

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

Number still struggling to get going anywhere with half the lambs of this sale last year but trade some 40p/kg dearer. Today's trade was sharper than last week by some 10p/kg & the recent wet weather & flush of fresh grass has brought some better lambs onto the market with these trading between 265 – 275p/kg topping at 289p/kg £110 for 38kg from M/s M J Hocken & Sons. The general run were 250 – 265p/kg around £100 - £105 a head. A few heavier lambs were all £120 topping at £130 for 56½kg from Mr G W Sivell.
