A pleasing entry sold to a good firm trade. The better Continental bulls sold over £300 to a top of £405 for a British Blue from M/s J & E Newton. The medium Continental bulls were £250 - £300. The native breeds saw a run of smart Hereford bulls to £355 (3 times) from M/s A & M Highman & Sons. Medium native breed bulls were £150 - £190.

The heifers saw a top of £310 for a Simmental from M/s R & T Andrews with most of the better sorts £220 - £260.

Friesian bulls saw the few better sorts topping at £150 from M/s R & T Andrews with mediums £50 - £100 and the rest £30 - £50.

A quite first sale of the year as expected with few cattle tested. Those forward were rewarded with a very good trade. A run of Continental cattle (12 – 16mths) from M/s S Hammond & Son, Poole Keynes saw Limousin steers to £1090 (201p/kg), £1050 (190p/kg) & £1045 (201p/kg) and their heifers to £1280 (193p/kg), £958 (201p/kg) & £900 (185p/kg). Strong Friesian steers (19 – 20mths) sold remarkable well to £958 (159p/kg) & £838 (148p/kg) from M/s T & S Pain, Tortworth.

Averages – Steers 185p/kg, Heifers 177p/kg, Cows 136p/kg

A good show of beef cattle sold to a good trade throughout. The few smart cattle traded over 200p/kg topping at 216p/kg for a 570kg Bazadaise steer from M/s P & T Akers. The commercial cattle seemed well sold trading between 180 – 190p/kg with the few overage & lesser sorts 170 – 180p/kg generally.

All beef cows on offer continue to sell extremely well and well ahead of most other local centres & deadweight. The best cows were 145 – 150p/kg topping at 170p/kg twice £1203 from M/s P & T Akers. A strong Charolais cows sold to £1382 (146p/kg) from M/s R & B Kimber. The medium beef cows seemed extremely dear between 120 – 128p/kg.
