## 266 TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £761 (166p/kg), Heifers £614 (155p/kg)

Generally an exceptionally good show of cattle with good strong cattle ready to feed for 2 to 3 months sold to a pleasing trade despite the easing beef trade.

The stronger near meat steers traded over £1100 topping at £1148 (1820p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s D Rumming & Sons, Lydiard Tregoze & £1145 (185p/kg) from M/s J & R Dunford, Honey Street.

The stronger farming cattle seemed well sold with the better steers £1030 - £1100 (180 - 190p/kg) with the general sorts £750 - £900 (155 - 170p/kg).

A few Friesian steers saw the stronger sorts topping at £860 (148p/kg) from M/s T & H Barber, North Nibley with the mediums £550 - £620 (120 - 130p/kg) and the smaller sorts hard work £400 - £500 (100 - 110p/kg).

The stronger farming heifers saw British Blue's to £1118 (186p/kg) from M/s T & H Barber, North Nibley with most £880 - £970 (160 - 165p/kg) The better younger & medium farming heifers seemed were between £760 - £820 (150 - 160p/kg).

A few harder bred weaned calves remain extremely difficult to place at an orange market except at low money.

Very little strength forward topping at £1090 (166p/kg) for an overage Aberdeen Angus heifer from Mr P Tutchter, Alderton. The stronger farming types were dearer with steers £800 - £900 (180 - 190p/kg) topping at £950 (174p/kg) & £848 (186p/kg) for Hereford steers from M/s A H Hook & Sons, Tortworth with their heifers to £835 (175p/kg). The younger & medium sorts saw steers £550 - £650 & heifers £500 - £620.

A few weaned calves met a stronger trade with a run of Limousin's (8 - 11mths) from M/s Cadenham Farms, Foxham to £810 (221p/kg) & £660 (200p/kg) & heifers £590 (170p/kg) & £555 (205p/kg). Aberdeen Angus steers (4 - 5mths) to £310 (258p/kg) from an exceptionally show of cattle with good strong cattle ready to feed for 2 to 3 months sold to a pleasing trade despite the easing beef trade..
