## 286 TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE

*Avg: Steers £955 (193p/kg), Heifers £755 (191p/kg)*

Another exceptionally good trade on a good show of mostly stronger or good farming cattle. The stronger near meat steers & heifers traded between £1250 - £1350 topping at £1430 (180p/kg) & £1390 (180p/kg) for Limousin & British Blue steers from Mr A Hunt, Oakridge.

The stronger farming cattle seemed exceptionally well sold with the better steers £1070 - £1150 (190 - 210p/kg) with the native breeds in strong demand topping at £1290 (200p/kg), £1280 (199p/kg) & £1225 (192p/kg) for Hereford steers from M/s J & R Dunford, Honey Street with their Aberdeen Angus to £1172 (209p/kg). The stronger farming heifers saw Limousin's to £985 (212p/kg) & £920 (209p/kg) from M/s A & J Morland, Shirley. The younger & medium farming heifers seemed well sold between £850 - £900 (190 - 200p/kg).

A few younger farming steers on offer selling well with the stronger sorts between £800 - £985 (205 - 215p/kg) & smaller sorts £500 - £700 (195 - 205p/kg) with the heifers £450 - £550 (170 - 180p/kg).

A few farming Friesian steers sold between £700 - £750 (150 - 160p/kg) topping at £760 (150p/kg) from Mr C Gallop, Minety.

Even the young weaned feeding bulls sold well with Friesian's (6 - 8mths) to £300 from M/s T & V Bennett, Ampney St Mary.

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

Another exceptionally strong trade on an entry of mostly medium & younger farming cattle with not too much strength on offer.

The stronger, farming steers traded over £1150 (195 - 210p/kg) topping at £1200 (195p/kg) for a Simmental steer from M/s K Wilson & Son, Crudwell. The medium term, farming steers saw the better sorts £1050 - £1130 (190 - 220p/kg) topping at £1182 (214p/kg) for Limousin steers from Mr A Gilder, Ledbury. The general stronger steers were £950 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg).

The younger & medium steers were again well sold between £850 - £950 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1180 (231p/kg) for a 14 month old British Blue steer from M/s K & A Godwin, North Wraxall.

The Friesian steers saw a top of £852 (162p/kg) & £802 (160p/kg) from M/s T & S Pain, Tortworth with the medium steers to £725 (176p/kg) from M/s Burcher, Son & Jones, Arlingham.

The stronger, short term farming heifers were around £1100 topping at £1155 twice (197p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus & (202p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s K & A Godwin, North Wraxall & Mr D Hillman, Rodbourne respectively.

The stronger farming heifers were again a very good trade between £950 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £800 - £900 (190 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

The weaned calves met a wonderful trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (12 - 14mths) to £955 (224p/kg) from Mrs D Bailey, Easton Grey. Limousin steers (8 - 10mths) sold to £870 (202p/kg) from Miss V Legge, Oldcroft & (11mths) to £735 (257p/kg) from M/s T Limbrick & Son, Sherborne with their Limousin heifers to £620 (238p/kg). British Blue heifers (8mths) sold to £658 (223p/kg) from M/s Merryfield Farms, Aldsworth.

Natives sold well with Aberdeen Angus bulls to £250 from Mr White and £235 for DW&SR Ingles. Good Hereford bulls to £292 from Ian Godwin.

Best Continental bulls in short supply but Robin Merrett topped with his British Blues at £365 and £400 & a good Simmental from Mike Pike at £362.

Heifer trade also firm £275 and £210 for British Blues from Robin Merrett, Aberdeen Angus £110 - £145 with a run of strong Hereford heifers out of Jersey cows strongly fought for to top at £150 avg £110 from PM Farms.

The heavier hoggetts again saw the meat well sold with the very best topping at £139 for 56kg from Mr H Todd. The general run were £120 - £130 with the leaner or lesser breeds £110 - £115. A few sheep pushing teeth were generally £90 for the stronger sorts.
