Many more calves could have been sold on today's trade but a shortage of calves forward with indifferent quality generally.

One very good Continental bull from RT & EB Townsend at £380 with good Limousin from RC Ponting & Son at £352 and £340.

One smart Friesian from JD Wright & Son at £108, best Hereford from AW Jones at £350.

Heifer trade very decent £228 for a British Blue from JD Wright & Son, Hereford heifers to £190 from Mr A W Jones & Simmental to £265 from RJ & TJ Andrews with Limousin £240 - £255 from Roy Townsend.

Another very good trade on a good show of mostly medium farming cattle. The stronger near meat steers & heifers traded between £1150 - £1220 topping at £1320 (171p/kg) & £1200 (180p/kg) for Continental steers from Mr A G Brind, Lower Stanton St Quinton. British Blue steers to £1255 (188p/kg) from Mrs G Greenaway, Cirencester. Native breeds saw a top of £1185 (182p/kg) for a Hereford steer from Mr J Puddephatt, Standish.

The Continental heifers saw a top of £1245 (193p/kg) & £1220 (180p/kg) for Charolais' from Mr M G Brind, Lower Stanton St Quinton with natives to £960 (186p/kg) from M/s C Cadogan & Son, Awre.

The stronger farming cattle again seemed exceptionally well sold with the better Continental steers £1050 - £1130 (190 - 205p/kg) with the natives £900 - £1000 (195 - 210p/kg). The younger & medium steers were again well sold between £800 - £900 (185 - 220p/kg). The stronger farming heifers met a firmer trade between £950 - £1050 (180 - 190p/kg) with the younger sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

The Friesian steers saw a top of £995 (167p/kg) from Mrs G Greenaway, Cirencester & £818 (152p/kg) from Mr J Puddephatt, Standish. The medium & younger sorts were £545 - £670 (125 - 135p/kg).

The weaned calves saw Aberdeen Angus steers (5 - 8mths) to £690 (219p/kg) from Mr G Potheary, Cricklade with Hereford steers (10 - 11mths) to £752 (200p/kg) from Mr G Vines, Brinkworth. Limousin steers (12mths) to £950 (226p/kg) from Miss M Allen, Blaisdon.

A run of organic cattle (9 - 12mths) from M/s W Slatter & Son, Farmington saw Charolais steers to £932 (245p/kg) & Limousin heifers to £800 (210p/kg).

APPLYING FOR A LICENCE HAS NOW CHANGED

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (fb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to CSC.TBlicensing@apha.gsi.gov.uk

APHA, Polwhele, Truro, Cornwall, TR4 9AD

Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

551 PRIME HOGGETTS

Hoggett SQQ 285.9p/kg Overall Average 281.5p/kg

The remarkable trade throughout the spring & summer last year & since Christmas has seen most of the hoggetts sold & gone, now resulting in a national shortage. The New Zealand supplies also at a shortage and heading for China & home & export buyers now desperate to supply orders.

You had to see the trade to believe it with the dearest trade ever seen, the better shaped, meat hoggetts selling to over 300p/kg on 8 occasions topping at 321p/kg £135 for 42kg & 311p/kg £126 for 40½kg from M/s P & R Clark. The entry is starting to struggle for quality with a lot of lean sheep on offer and these were £85 - £100 (up some £20 in a week)

The heavier hoggetts you could just pick a figure with the better sorts £140 - £145 topping at £149 for 56kg from M/s M J C Hocken & Sons. (up some £30 - £35 a head in a week & £20 on the start of the week).

One pen of spring lambs weighed 34kg and sold to £111 (326p/kg) from M/s L & R Underwood.
