Strong Aberdeen Angus bulls from M/s C & E Best sold to £400, heifer trade saw Aberdeen Angus to £300 from the same home. Simmental to £272 from m/s EJ Pike & Son.

Weaned Friesians sold well to £250 from Mr C Lloyd, £400 for Aberdeen Angus and £420 for British Blues from M/s DJ & NJ Wall.

Another pleasing entry for the time of year considering the weather and met a good solid trade and better than many expected but the lesser sorts a shade easier with grass now becoming a worry for some.

A few stronger farming cattle on offer trading between £1030 - £1100 (188 - 200p/kg) topping at £1195 (196p/kg) for Limousin steers from Mr S K Batt, Longhope. The medium term farming steers saw the better sorts £860 - 960 (190 - 205p/kg) topping at £1025 (203p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s A & V Albutt & Sons, Winchcombe. The lesser shaped or smaller sorts were £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg) generally.

The heifers saw a top of £1050 (184p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s A & P Mason, Ablington with the stronger farming sorts £880 - £980 (185 - 192p/kg). Medium term heifers were £700 - £800 (175 - 185p/kg).

The weaned calves & young stores were a shade easier with a few farmer customers busy on the fields. Smart British Blue bulls (3 - 5mths) sold to £575 (245p/kg) from M/s D & N Wall, Elmstone Hardwicke with Aberdeen Angus steers (3 - 5mths) to £342 (311p/kg) from M/s K & C Gough, Ogbourne St George. Very shapely British Blue steers (11mths) from Mr D Hillman, Rodbourne sold to £878 (181p/kg) with his heifer to £710 (222p/kg). Simmental steers (9 - 10mths) sold to £648 (196p/kg) from Mrs C Tyler, Abingdon & a run of Welsh Black steers (10 - 12mths) sold to £750 (183p/kg) & £745 (186p/kg) from MR J King, Brockworth.

The best good meat lambs traded around the 200p/kg and over topping at 216p/kg £80 for 37kg from Mr H J Noad. The fair meat but looser coated sorts were 190 – 195p/kg with the leaner sorts 185 – 190p/kg.

A few heavier lambs topped at £100 twice for 47kg & 69kg from M/s D T & R Williams & Son & M/s R J & B Kimber respectively.

A very good entry compared to recent weeks and the most wonderful trade you would wish to experience. Those selling cows privately or direct must take a look at what we are achieving.

A tremendous run of Simmental beef cows met strong bidding and achieving 157 – 169p/kg and twice at 1455, then £1357, £1331, £1275 & £1180 from M/s E Amesbury. M/s R & R James sold Bazadaise cows to £1244 with others to £1190 & £1091. Medium & plainer beef cows were 110 – 120p/kg. Only a handful of dairy cows on offer with mediums to 125p/kg (£847) & plain sorts 89 – 100p/kg.

The beef cattle also sold well for type but those over 36mths or non-farm assured so suffer a bit. Friesian steers to 170p/kg twice (£923 & £860) with non-farm assured heifers 160 – 180p/kg. Mr A Hunt sold steers to £1307 with heifers to £1242 from Mr D Barton.
