59 REARING CALVES

Bulls £440, Heifers £360

Plenty of strength on offer with some good quality calves mixed in and a decent trade throughout. The Friesians averaged £132 and topped at £208 for a pair from PJ & SR Bennett that were 3 months.

A run of part weaned Hereford x calves (Feb-May) sold up to £288 for steers and £265 for heifers with a very nice Hereford bull (2 weeks) from AR & M Highman at £302. On the Continentals from a good Limousin bull from C & E Best made £365, a quality British Blue from JR & SE Cook took £440 with Simmental from Richard Andrews at £430.

Heifers sold well - JR & SE Cook sold a superb British Blue heifer at £360 with the smaller native heifers looking good money up to £150, Limousin sold to £220 from C & E Best.

A weaned British Blue bull from GM & NF Lambert made £540 whilst a smaller aged heifer made £395. Friesians 3-4 months made a good £248 from C Lloyd.

A remarkable entry of quality cattle and a credit to vendors for such a magnificent show. This was met with a trade to match from the smaller farming sorts to the very best. The highlight of the sale was 165 Limousin steers & heifers from M/s B Buckingham & Sons, Barnard Gate with many comments from all who attended on the top quality that was on offer.

Their stronger farming short term steers were a very good trade topping at £1420 (201p/kg) & £1300 (216p/kg). The medium term, farming steers (13 - 17mths) saw bunch after bunch over £1100 (215 - 225p/kg) topping at £1205 (227p/kg). Their younger farming steers (6 - 13mths) seemed the dearest in comparison £920 - £1050 (230 - 260p/kg).

Their heifers saw the stronger sorts over £1050 topping at £1100 (220p/kg). The medium term sorts (13 - 16mths) were £870 - £995 (200 - 220p/kg) with the younger sorts £720 - £800 (220 - 240p/kg).

Strong Limousin x steers from Mr K Perry, Upleadon sold to £1288 (211p/kg) & £1150 (212p/kg) with his heifers to £1060 (200p/kg). The native breeds saw an average Aberdeen Angus steer to £1170 (170p/kg) from M/s T Rymer & Son, Uley with Hereford steers to £1085 (190p/kg) from M/s T & J Wyatt, Eastington. Their Hereford heifers sold to £1082 (183p/kg) & £1058 (180p/kg). Only one lot of Friesian steers sold to £940 (188p/kg) from Mr R Gawthrop, Little Somerford.

A good trade on the weaned calves & young stores with Aberdeen Angus steers (9 - 10mths) to £835 (238p/kg) from M/s D & J Gilder, Winchcombe with their heifers to £690 (184p/kg). Aberdeen Angus steers (13mths) to £800 (192p/kg) from M/s C Harber & Son, Earls Croome. Simmental steers (13mths) to £948 (213p/kg) from Mr B Hillman, Rodbourne with his heifers (12 - 14mths) to £900 (193p/kg).

Double the amount forward but numbers still struggling nationally. Trade just easing back but better than many expected and the best lambs 260 – 270p/kg topping at 273p/kg £105 for 38½kg from M/s P & T Akers. The general run saw a larger percentage of lighter lights 33 – 36kg and were 245 – 255p/kg around £85 - £90 a head. Very few heavier lambs sold to a top of £115 for 44½kg from Barbury Castle Estate.
