



CIRENCESTER LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

TUESDAY 5TH MARCH 2019

425 STORE CATTLE

11.30 am - Auctioneers: Jon Pullin & Chris Voyce
 Avg: Steers £807 (175p/kg), Heifers £670 (160p/kg)

A very good entry sold to another good trade with some good farming cattle on offer. Trade is generally harder work with a continual dropping beef trade and a bit of uncertainty of the future.

Not too many real strong cattle on offer topping at £1195 (175p/kg) for a Simmental steer from M/s H C Jones & Son, Bourton. A good show of stronger farming sorts saw the Continental steers a good trade between £1000 - £1100 (185 - 200p/kg) topping at £1105 (200p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s A & J Morland, Shirley & £1100 (180p/kg) from M/s Millard Bros, Coopers Hill. The general Continental steers were £900 - £1000 (175 - 185p/kg). The younger Continental steers were a good, firm trade which included a grand run of cattle (10 - 12mths) from M/s N & J Gilder & Son, Aston on Carrant topping at £980 (202p/kg), £970 (212p/kg) & £952 (200p/kg).

A good show of farming native breeds met a similar trade with a top of £1022 (189p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from M/s J A Jones & Son, Cricklade with Hereford steers to £975 (180p/kg) from M/s W & D Hillier, Sherston.

The Friesian steers saw a top of £795 (140p/kg) & £790 (145p/kg) from M/s A & J Terrett, Sheperdine. The stronger sorts were generally £680 - £750 (130 - 140p/kg) with medium sorts £500 - £600 (105 - 115p/kg).

A good show of stronger farming heifers saw Simmental heifers topping at £1070 (178p/kg) from M/s H C Jones & Son, Bourton with most £860 - £950 (170 - 180p/kg). The good younger farming sorts were £750 - £850 (180 - 190p/kg) with the general sorts well sold between £680 - £780 (150 - 160p/kg). A good trade on the native breeds topping at £915 (160p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton.

The younger heifers saw the better sorts well sold with Limousin's to £852 (183p/kg), £758 (180p/kg) & £752 (183p/kg) from M/s N & J Gilder & Son, Aston on Carrant.

The weaned calves saw Simmental steers to £680 (188p/kg) from Mr A Langsbury, Andoversford & £675 (180p/kg) from M/s W Lane & Partners, Denchworth with their heifers to £692 (189p/kg).

77 REARING CALVES

Bulls £325, Heifers £195

Quite a difficult day's trading with many 2nd quality calves on offer and at two tier demand. Best calves wanted and at good money but lower than they have been and many 2nd & 3rd quality calves very difficult to sell.

Friesians to £30 top, killing trade weakened by the large number of New Zealand type bull calves which have flooded the market so limited demand. Best natives sold to £235 for Aberdeen Angus bull from Robin Merrett and Hereford to £225 for K D Sheridan, but Aberdeen Angus bulls averaged £95, Herefords £128 showing the quality throughout.

Best Continentals saw British Blue bulls to £280 and £260 from Robin Merrett with Simmental to £270 for RJ & TJ Andrews. Limousin's topped the day at £325 for TT & H Barber, 40 Bulls avg £120.

Heifer trade a similar story with bet sorts £160+ to a top of £180 for FE White & Sons and £190 for Simmental from EJ Pike & Son. Limousin to £180 for RC Ponting & Son.

Weaned British Blue steers to £400 from L Lewis, Hereford heifers to £300 from Andy Tuck.

Another pleasing entry and the same story as last week we can sell what they can sell. The entry saw nearly 60% of hoggetts over 45kg and this week nationally have been a more difficult trade.

The handyweight hoggetts were very good and saw the better export types 200 - 210p/kg topping at 211p/kg £77 for 36½kg from Mr B Foy. The general handyweights were also well sold in comparison between 195 - 200p/kg.

The medium weight 45 - 48kg hoggetts are the most difficult to sell but our trade was one of the best of the week with most £79 - £82. The heavier hogs were as dear as anywhere this week but are a more difficult trade just because of the numbers forward. The better sorts were £86 - £88 topping at £90 twice for 52kg & 54½kg from M/s D & A Dando & Mr D M Clark respectively. The more looser coated sorts & lesser breeds were £80 - £84.

1 spring lamb weighed 36½kg and sold to £80 (219p/kg) from M/s P & T Akers.
