A tremendous trade on all types forward with about a third being weaned calves.

Fresh sorts saw good rearing interest in the Friesians selling to £194 for M D Pike and £280 for WJ Tinney & Sons. A run of native calves saw Hereford bulls to £340 for AR & M Highman and Aberdeen Angus to £370 for R & R Baker and £355 for Rawlings & Davis, avg £272.

A Fleckvieh bull sold to £360 for Cimarron Partnership and best Simmentals to £395 for RJ & TJ Andrews. British Blue's again top reaching £430 for Anton Smith.

Heifer trade remains firm, British Blue's to £355 for Cimarron Partnership and a top Charolais from DJ Spratt at £320, Simmental to £300 for M D Pike, Limousin sold to £300 for GJ & FL Robertson, Hereford topped at £245 for AR & M Highman.

31 weaned from AJ Gibbs, Sodbury sold well all 3-4 months saw British Blues steers / bulls to £465, Aberdeen Angus to £415, Hereford £430 and Limousin £458. Heifers sold exceptionally well with British Blue's to £435, Shorthorn to £420, Herefords to £485 and £400 and a smart pen of farming Limousin's at £488.

A pleasing entry of mainly farming types sold to an exceptional trade throughout.

The few stronger near meat steers traded over £1200 topping at £1450 (188p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus steer from M/s K & A Godwin, North Wraxall & £1305 (190p/kg) for a Simmental from M/s R Breakspear & Son, Standford Dingley. The stronger farming cattle seemed exceptionally well sold with the better steers £1050 - £1150 (220 - 235p/kg) which

included a run of Charolais steers from Mrs H Whitcombe, Minety selling to £1175 (237p/kg), £1115 (234p/kg), £1108 (228p/kg) & £1020 (231p/kg).

The native breeds were also an extremely good trade topping at £1200 (156p/kg) for a Hereford steer from Mrs J Dawson, Winchcombe.

A few stronger Friesian steers sold to £925 (154p/kg) from M/s T Rymer & Son, Uley.

Strong, near meat heifers topped at £1138 (210/kg) for a Charolais from M/s H Whitcombe, Minety & £1115 (180p/kg) for a Hereford from Mrs J Dawson, Winchcombe & £1110 (219/kg) for a Charolais from M/s S Poultney & Son, Frocester. The stronger farming heifers were £950 - £1030 with the medium types £800 - £900.

A handful of weaned calves saw Hereford steers (8mths) to £620 (206p/kg) from Mr R Hobbs, Swindon & Aberdeen Angus bulls (4mths) to £490 (288p/kg) from Mr E Gilder, Elmstone Hardwicke.

We knew this day was coming and after the heights of the festival trade the middle part of the week saw the trade drop back to normal (which was still okay but a shock when it drops 20p/kg in a week).

The short entry helped today with large numbers out nationally all week and home & export buyers struggling to cope with numbers for this week's demand. A mixed show on offer with good meat best lambs in short supply selling between 180 – 186p/kg topping at 190p/kg £74 for 39kg from Mr A Grindle. The better meat commercial lambs were 170 – 178p/kg with the leaner & lesser bred sorts 165 – 172p/kg. The heavier lambs were generally £80 - £83 topping at £85.50 for 46kg from Mr R Richins.
