36 REARING CALVES

Top Prices: Bulls £382, Heifers £330

Last week's snow did not help numbers forward today and demand was weaker as a result. Only a handful of Friesian bulls on offer topping at £78 & £70 from M/s J D Wright & Son. The native bulls saw a top of £245 for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s T & H Barber with the rest being second & third quality. 2 Best British Blue bulls made £382 each from M/s J & S Cook & M/s J D Wright & Son. The heifer trade was firm for the best at £330 & £320 for British Blue's from M/s C & E Best. Hereford's to £240 from Mr A W Jones & Limousin's to £240 from M/s C & E Best. The weaned calves (2 - 4mths) saw Hereford bulls to £350 & British Blue bulls to £418 from M/s Whistledown Farms.

Avg: Steers £914 (206p/kg), Heifers £747 (191p/kg)

A very pleasing entry sold to another extremely good trade and probably the dearest of the season with all types well sold. The stronger farming Continental steers met a very good trade helped by a lift in the beef prices due to the winter weather. The better sorts traded over £1150 (200 - 220p/kg) topping at £1200 (200p/kg) & £1170 (205p/kg) for Charolais steers from Mr G Beale, Leighterton. The mid age cattle Continental steers were £1000 - £1100 (190 - 215p/kg) with the younger sorts £850 - £950 (200 - 220p/kg). The native breed steers saw a top of £1090 (207p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus again from Mr G Beale, Leighterton with the farming steers £900 - £1000 (200 - 210p/kg). A grand run of 125 Aberdeen Angus steers & heifers (10 - 11mths) from M/s Barley Park Farms, Ducklington saw the steers to £955 (230p/kg), £942 (227p/kg), £912 (230p/kg) with the heifers £800 (200p/kg), £795 (206p/kg), £785 (206p/kg) & £762 (208p/kg). The Friesian's steers were short in number with a top of £1150 (146p/kg) from M/s West View Farms, Wanborough. The stronger sorts were generally £1000 (160 - 180p/kg) with the medium types £770 - £850 (145 - 165p/kg).

Not much strength in the heifers with the stronger farming Continental heifers trading around the £1000 mark topping at £1075 (202p/kg) from Mr G Beale, Leighterton. The good farming sorts were £850 - £950 (190 - 220p/kg) with the lesser sorts well sold between £680 - £750 (170 - 180p/kg).

The younger stores & weaned calves met an extremely good trade with Simmental steers (10 - 11mths) to £940 (206p/kg) & £862 (226p/kg) & heifers to £795 (193p/kg) from Mr J Daniels, Turkdean. Aberdeen Angus steers (11mths) to £878 (219p/kg) from Mr G Vines, Brinkworth with his heifers to £720 (194p/kg).

Rather than making your application by telephone, Animal health now require a completed application form (tb204) to be completed & emailed / posted to
CSC.TBlicensing@apha.gsi.gov.uk
APHA, Polwhele, Truro, Cornwall, TR4 9AD
Please note: Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).
Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.
The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.

Trade has continued on at a fantastic trade this week with more numbers out this week everywhere but trade not been affected.

The handyweight hogs again saw mostly lesser breeds & leaner sorts with the few better sorts 220 – 228p/kg topping at 229p/kg £95 for 41½kg from Mr R Edwards & M/s D & M Whitcombe. The general hogs were 205 – 215p/kg and seemed well sold.

The heavier hoggets saw the better sheep with some grand hoggs on offer. The better shaped hoggs traded between 220 – 230p/kg £108 - £112 topping at 237p/kg £115 for 48½kg from Mr S T Redman & £117 from M/s D & A Dando. The general heavy hoggs were 208 – 216p/kg £102 - £105.

A short entry of pigs dominated by rearing pigs with only a small show of limited quality fat. For all sorts of reasons the trade and demand remains difficult and with all other types of meat selling at high levels you would expect a reaction in the pig trade.

The sows remain difficult to trade between 30 – 40p/kg with a good sow from Mr W J Winning to £120 with other better sorts £75 - £110 & feeding & Small sorts £30 - £50. A good Meatlink boar sold to £100 & in pig sows to £71.

In honesty a poor show of fat pigs on offer with the better sorts £70 - £75. The weaning pigs also hard work but all changed hands. Gloucester Old Spot weaners to £20 - £22 from Mrs J Simms & stronger sorts from Mr A J Park £31 - £33. A few smaller sorts £5 - £10.
