Another firm trade with a good contingent of buyers and a good show of calves to sell. Friesians better quality and therefore money selling to £130 for JR & ED Newton, £84 for FE White avg £70. 2 weaned Friesians made £200 per head.

Native bulls sold to £320 twice for Hereford for AR & M Highman & Son and FC Price. Angus Twice to £342 for R Beard & Son, Native bull avg £260.

Continental bulls sold well, Blondes to £362 for DE Meredith, Blues to £425 (Anton Smith) and £412 FC Price & Son. Ken Samuel came down from Tewkesbury to secure £418 and £395 for two good Simmental bulls. Heifer trade, similar to last week, Blonde to £215, Blues £280-£340 for JR & ED Newton, Simmental to £260, Hereford and Angus £140-£160 generally top £220 for R Beard & Son.

Weaned Blue bulls to £410 and Limousins at £440 for SJ Potter. Weaned heifers sold to £360 for PE King Ltd.

A very good entry saw a run of Limousin & Blonde cows with young Blonde x calves at foot from Mrs H Knight, West Littleton selling to £1340, £1160 & £970 for bull calves & £1230, £1190 & 1060 for heifer calves. A run of incalf Hereford heifers (PD+ 2 - 5mths to Aberdeen Angus) sold between £900 - £1020 from Ms S Parker, Burmington. Grazing cows saw British Blues to £1035 from Mr D Rowles, Cambridge. A young pedigree Hereford bull sold to £1100 from M/s G Timbrell & Son, Poole Keynes with a smart pedigree Charolais bull to £1510 from M/s J Preece & Sons, Elmstone Hardwicke.

### 254 STORE CATTLE

Avg: Steers £840 (178p/kg), Heifers £737 (160p/kg)

A similar entry met a similar trade generally with the stronger and better sorts well sold, the lesser sorts the hardest to place & the weaned calves a very strong trade.

The stronger farming cattle traded between £1020 - £1100 (170 - 175p/kg) topping at £1140 (175p/kg) for British Blue steers from M/s H P Nicholas & Sons, High Woolaston. The general well grown farming steers traded between £940 - £1000 (175 - 185p/kg) & the younger sorts £800 - £900 (190 - 200p/kg).

The Friesian steers saw the stronger sorts £720 - £780 (140 - 150p/kg) topping at £790 twice (146p/kg) & (154p/kg) from M/s P & J Holness, Leighton & M/s C T Poultney & Sons, Dursley respectively. The medium sorts were £660 - £720 (135 - 142p/kg).

No real strength in the heifers with the general farming heifers £750 - £850 (165 - 175p/kg) with the younger & lesser sorts £650 - £750 (155 - 165p/kg).

A weaned calves met a much sharper trade with a run of Simmental steers (7 - 8mths) from M/s W Lane & Partners, Denchworth selling to £890 (234p/kg), £855 (259p/kg), £805 (272p/kg) & £800 (262p/kg). Aberdeen Angus steers (7mths) from M/s Ellipsis Farms, Sevenhampton sold to £680 (203p/kg) with their heifers to £570 (175p/kg).

A bit more spark to the trade than last week with number still short at most centres. Today saw a mixed show of lambs on offer with the better shaped meated lambs traded between 171 – 175p/kg with a few smart pens 195p/kg – 200p/kg topping at 205p/kg £85 for 41½kg from S Gore. The general commercial lambs were 167 – 170p/kg with the looser coated & leaner types 158 – 160p/kg generally. The heavier sorts 46 – 50kg trading anywhere between £75 - £80 depending on shape & finish.
