91 REARING CALVES

10.30 am - Auctioneers: Jon Pullin
Bulls £350, Heifers £300

A difficult trade experienced today with buyers generally lacking interest and much talk of difficult weather conditions for rearing calves. All calves however were sold but the better calves less than they have been and as always looking the best value.

A handful of diary bred bulls averaged £40 with Friesian to £70 and Brown Swiss to £85 and a Fleckvieh and £135 for the Cimarron Partnership. Native's breeds saw best Hereford bulls from AW Jones and J Stagg & Son reaching £220 and medium Aberdeen Angus to £182.

In the Continental section, British Blue bulls topped at £350 from Harrow Farms and £325 for DJ & NJ Wall. Best Simmentals sold twice to £300 for RJ & TJ Andrews.

A British Blue heifer topped at £300 for DH & DR Smart but generally £140-£150 would buy most heifers on offer but in fairness, quality was limited.

A quantity of weaned calves saw a Longhorn steer at £310 with a tidy bunch of Charolais heifers at £340 and 9 month Aberdeen Angus heifers at £332.

A very pleasing entry for the first sale of the year and sold to a good, firm trade. A good crowd of buyers in attendance saw the stronger short term, near meat steers sold well between £1130 - £1200 (165 - 175p/kg) topping at £1230 (164p/kg) for a Simmental & £1208 (183p/kg) for Limousin steers from M/s H P Nicholas & Sons, High Woolaston.

A good entry of stronger, farming steers and sold to good trade with Continental steers £950 - £1050 (180 - 190p/kg) topping at £1085 (192p/kg) for Charolais steers (14 - 16mths) from M/s A & P Cutler & Son, Fairford. The general farming steers were £850 - £900 (170 - 180p/kg).

A good trade on the few Friesian steers topping at £775 (134p/kg) from Mr A Gilder, Ledbury & £750 (135p/kg) from M/s K & W Kingston, Wickwar.

The stronger Continental heifers saw the better, short term topping at £1105 (174p/kg) again from M/s H P Nicholas & Sons, High Woolaston. The stronger farming heifers were £850 - £980 (170 - 185p/kg) topping at £985 (189p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s J & C Elliott, Purton Stoke. The general sorts £750 - £850 (160 - 170p/kg) & the few lesser sorts were £570 - £620 (140 - 160p/kg).

A few weaned calves were a good trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (7 - 8mths) to £550 (170p/kg) from M/s C Logan & Son, Brinkworth. Devon steers (9mths) sold to £635 from M/s Stoneridge Farms, with their Hereford heifers (6mths) to £460.

Trade has firmed this week with the export hoggets if ticking all the boxes were 195 - 200p/kg topping at 215p/kg £88 for 41kg from Mr C Benson. The more looser coated or lesser bred handyweights were 180 - 185p/kg.

The medium weight 45 - 48kg hoggets were mostly the looser coated types and traded between £82 - £86. The meated heavier hoggs were in short supply trading around £90 topping at £95 for 56½kg from M/s S & E Ractliffe.

No significant change to the cull sow and boar trade but very few best Sows on offer, £40-£70 covered most sorts forward with two best white sows topping at £90 from R Maslin.

The fat pig trade was reasonable but in fairness no best quality forward. Two gold pigs from Blackwell Farm made £75 and 4 tidy pigs from Gwen Norris sold well to achieve £80.
