Avg: Steers £855 (196p/kg), Heifers £734 (190p/kg)

Another exceptionally good entry with the warm summer weather taking preference with a few buyers but trade still remarkably strong.

The very best strong farming steers saw some exceptionally good shapey cattle on offer trading between £1250 - £1390 (210 - 237p/kg) topping at £1430 (210p/kg) for British steers from M/s J Bell & Son, Tetbury. The stronger farming steers were £1100 - £1190 (190 - 210p/kg) topping at £1200 (195p/kg) for a Simmental from Mr R Jackson, Sevenhampton.

The medium term, farming steers saw the better sorts £1050 - £1100 (190 - 220p/kg) with the general stronger steers were £950 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg).

The younger & medium steers were again well sold but maybe a shade easier between £850 - £950 (190 - 210p/kg) topping at £1080 (190p/kg) for Blonde steers from Mr R Cook, Bussage & Aberdeen Angus steers (12 - 13mnths) to £1000 (204p/kg) from M/s R & B Rawlings, Charlton.

The Friesian steers saw a top of £880 twice (163p/kg) from M/s M Maslin & Son, Brinkworth & (164p/kg) from M/s F Powell & Sons, Avening. The medium steers were £700 - £780 (150 - 160p/kg) with the younger sorts £455 - £550 (130 - 145p/kg).

The stronger, short term farming heifers were over £1050 topping at £1105 (190p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s H E Farnsworth & Son, Chedworth Laines. The stronger farming heifers were again a very good trade between £950 - £1050 (185 - 200p/kg) with the better younger sorts £800 - £900 (190 - 210p/kg) & general sorts £700 - £800 (170 - 180p/kg).

The weaned calves met another very good trade with Aberdeen Angus steers (11 - 13mnths) to £820 (215p/kg) from Mrs D Bailey, Easton Grey. British Blue steers (10mnths) to £775 (209p/kg) from M/s J D Wright & Son, Baydon & (4 - 9mnths) to £855 (237p/kg) & £600 (300p/kg) from M/s E & H Sheldon & Sons, Stinchcombe with their British Blue heifers (7 - 9mnths) to £675 (207p/kg). Hereford steers (12mnths) sold to £725 (219p/kg) from M/s F Powell & Sons, Avening. Aberdeen Angus heifers (8 - 10mnths) sold to £572 (200p/kg) from Mr O Costar, Standlake & (9 - 12mnths) to £645 (195p/kg) from M/s P & S Bennett, Tockenham.

**Please note:** Licenses are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time. Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence).

Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home.

The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.
