



CIRENCESTER LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

TUESDAY 9TH OCTOBER 2018

147 REARING CALVES

10.30 am - Auctioneers: Jon Pullin
Bulls £388, Heifers £250

All pens full today and a very selective trade for all on offer. A large number of decent shaped dairy breeds (35) topped at £70 for FL Price & Sons but sadly, not enough going to rearing homes, probably due to the larger numbers of calves available and general worries over winter feed supplies. The 35 averaged £42.

Native trade also selective however no first quality sorts on offer, medium Hereford bulls traded £160 - £190 however the smaller bulls looked good value in the £100 - £120 bracket. Similar trade for Aberdeen Angus with the exception of 1st quality from C J Gallop at £280 and £270 for R Beard & Son. Continental bulls generally short and first quality rearing scarce. DE Meredith sold Blonde's at £345 with British Blues from Cimarron Partnership to £388 and £375 for K D Sheridan. A smart Simmental from RC Ponting & Son sold to £385 but the Continental bulls averaged £230 per head.

Heifer calf trade similarly selective and quality low in supply. British Blue to £250 for KD Sheridan with 9 averaging £145. Simmental sold to £210 for RJ & TJ Andrews with all in average just over £100 per head. A few best natives saw Hereford to £138 and £145 for Alf Jones and Angus to £175 for R Beard & Son, many Herefords heifers bringing the overall average to about £70.

21 weaned on offer with a mixed show of breeds. Aberdeen Angus males 3-4 months sold to £230 for FE White & Son, Hereford to £235 from J Voyce who also sold Longhorn to £150, Limousin from RW Bevin sold well at £400.

Shorthorn heifers sold to £345 for HJ & PV Saunders who also sold Hereford to £380. Longhorn heifers sold to £130.

A similar number forward but again a lot of cattle showing signs of the weather and one of the hardest trades for a long time but still ahead of many of the other centres. As in previous weeks the stronger and better bred cattle remain a good trade but the second & third quality sorts extremely difficult to sell.

The stronger farming steers despite the increasing food costs remain a fair trade between £980 - £1050 ((165 - 180p/kg) topping at £1088 (178p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from M/s J & R Dunford, Honey Street.

The better bred younger & stronger farming steers were again a good solid trade trading between £900 - £960 (170 - 190p/kg) topping at £990 (194p/kg) for Limousin steers from M/s A & J Morland, Solihull. The younger sorts were between £750 - £825 (175 - 200p/kg). The second & third quality sorts have become extremely difficult to place except at low money mostly £450 - £5500 (125 - 140p/kg).

The Friesian steers are generally hard to place with one pen of better British Friesian steers to £888 (157p/kg) from M/s J & R Dunford, Honey Street. The medium sorts were £450 - £540 (110 - 120p/kg).

Again the same story with the heifers with the few stronger near meat sorts trading between £950 - £1030 (150 - 160p/kg) topping at £1088 (161p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s M & P Slinger, Edge. The stronger farming heifers were generally £770 - £850 (155 - 170p/kg) topping at £935 (183p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s A & V Albutt & Sons, Winchcombe. The medium types £620 - £700 (150 - 160p/kg) & lesser sorts £450 - £550 (110 - 130p/kg).

A few decent weaned calves saw strong Simmental steers (7 - 10mths) to £760 (178p/kg) & £ 690 (184p/kg) from Mr J Millard, Grittenham.

Exactly the same number forward and trade continues at the same levels. The overall average tells more of the quality of entry than the trade. No real top ewes on offer with the stronger Continental & Suffolk topping at £80 with the half meated sorts £60 - £75. The medium half meated ewes were £45 - £55 & smaller sorts £35 - £45. Leaner grazing types were £30 - £40 with only the very small or very plain £15 - £20 generally.

A mixed entry of beef cattle. The few smarter sorts saw Limousin heifers to 199p/kg £1210 from M/s T & J Wyatt.

The general run of cattle were 186 – 190p/kg with a few leaner sorts 160 – 170p/kg.

Despite the cow trade easing deadweight our trade was still strong. The few better beef cows were 135 – 140p/kg topping at 159p/kg for a Bazadaise from M/s P & T Akers. The stronger dairy bred sorts were 115 – 120p/kg with medium cows 97 – 105p/kg with plainer sorts 74 – 83p/kg.
