15 REARING CALVES

10.30 am – Auctioneer: Richard Barrow
Rearing Calves Bulls to £220, Heifers to £198

Numbers remain short with a Simmental bull topping the day at £220 from M/s E J Pike & Son. Native bulls to £215 for a Longhorn & £205 for a Hereford from M/s E & E Godsell & Partners. Medium bulls were generally £180 - £200. Heifers topped at £198 for a Longhorn from the same home with most £120 - £150.

198 STORE CATTLE

Steers to £1740 Avg £1121 (257p/kg), Heifers to £1400 Avg £900 (229p/kg)

A similar entry saw another remarkable trade with not the quality of recent weeks.

Not too many short-term steers on offer trading to a top of £1740 (272p/kg) for a Hereford from Mr D T Parry, Standish.

The stronger medium-term steers that saw the better sorts trading extremely dear again over £1450 (255 - 280p/kg) topping at £1575 (279p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus from Mr G Potheary, Cricklade. The farming medium term steers looked another very good trade with between £1150 - £1350 (250 - 290p/kg).

The younger steers sold to another very sharp trade with the highlight being some cracking Limousin's (11 - 13mths) from M/s W E & M Gash, Leigh selling to £1615 (276p/kg). £1555 (278p/kg) & £1495 (312p/kg).

A few medium Friesian steers all traded around 200p/kg topping at £1015 (200p/kg) from Mrs Y Gainey, Chippenham.

The stronger weaned steers traded between £900 - £1000 (250 - 280p/kg) with the smaller and younger sorts £650 - £800.

The stronger medium-term heifers also saw a very good trade topping at £1400 (257p/kg) for a Simmental from Exors of Mrs G Greenaway, Cirencester with Aberdeen Angus heifers to £1312 (273p/kg) from M/s R & R Baker, Charlton. with most £1200 - £1300 (235 - 255p/kg). The farming heifers traded between £1050 - £1200 (225 - 255p/kg).

The younger & the smaller longer-term heifers traded between £800 - £900 (210 - 240p/kg). with the stronger weaned heifers traded between £700 - £800 (240 - 250p/kg) & smaller sorts £500 - £600 (200 - 215p/kg).

LICENCES FOR TB RESTRICTED SALE HAVE CHANGED

From 2nd October 2023, keepers of TB restricted herds will be able to apply for a general licence to cover the movement of cattle directly or through an Approved Dedicated Sale for TB-restricted cattle (an "orange market") in England or Wales. The general licence (TB16e) will be valid for the time between short-interval tests. A new licence will need to be applied for after each short-interval test. You still have to complete a TB204 form to apply for the licence and within 90 days of TB test.

Hogget SQQ 368.9p/kg Overall Average 370.3p/kg

Another decent entry and they keep getting dearer with trade some 20 – 30p/kg dearer than last week and up 128p/kg on this sale last year. With an overall average of £160.46 (all in which included a fair selection of rare & lesser breeds) Again, not the best show in in the light & handyweights with a larger percentage of lesser breeds and leaner sorts.

Th better sorts met an exceptional record-breaking trade between 390 – 400p/kg topping at 421p/kg £177 for 42kg from M/s D J & A C Dando. The general handyweight meat sorts looked the dearest in comparison trading between 370 – 385p/kg with the few loose coated, lesser breeds looking extremely dear trading between 330 – 350p/kg generally.

The medium weight hoggs (46 – 52kg) again saw another excellent show and also saw another sharper trade with the better sorts 385 – 400p/kg topping at 411p/kg £195 for 47½kg from Mr B Strange. The majority of the better sorts traded between £170 - £200 topping at £210 for 52kg (404p/kg) from Mr G King. The next level still looked extremely well sold trading between 375 – 385p/kg £175 - £185.

The heavier hoggs (52kg+) broke last week's record levels and all traded over £200 topping at £220 twice for 58½kg & 60kg from Mr R Goodman & Mr R Keepence respectively.

The general medium hoggs took another lift and look extremely well sold trading between £110 - £120. The smaller sorts were the dearer ever between £90 - £105 with the very small & backward hoggs hard to believe between £50 - £75.

EWES & LAMBS (12 & 15) Another run of ewes and young lambs from M/s Allspheres farm saw doubles to £210 (£70 a life) with singles to £197 (£98.50 a life), £194 (£97 a life) & £186 twice (£93 a life)

CULL EWES (523) Another good but shorter entry with less numbers out generally everywhere this week as trade had eased back slightly. Trade with us was just a good and sharper than the previous week. Only a few best end Continental ewes trading well between £155 - £169. A good show of stronger Continental x & Suffolk ewes saw the better sorts £130 - £148. The medium sized and half meat ewes traded between £110 - £120. The smaller meat ewes traded between £85 - £100.

Not many best Mules on offer and mostly medium types or leaner sorts trading between £90 - £110 generally.

The lean, grazing ewes saw the stronger ewes £85 - £90 with the next level £65 - £80 and plainer sorts £50 - £60.
