Steers to £2270 Avg £1831 (368p/kg), Heifers to £1980 Avg £1398 (328p/kg)

A decent entry with a wonderful show of good stronger farming cattle and 9 buyers in attendance all looking for cattle. Trade was extremely strong throughout with a run of good, shaped Limousin steers from R B Lewis Farming Partnership, Leamington Spa selling to £2270 (360p/kg), £2260 (404p/kg), £2160 (372p/kg) & £2100 (396p/kg). Limousin steers sold to £2100 (393p/kg) from M/s A E & V Albutt & Sons, Winchcombe with their Beef Shorthorn steers to £2080 (389p/kg). Mr S Wilson, Andover sold Simmental steers to £2240 (361p/kg) & £2080 (353p/kg) with his Hereford steers to £2070 (376p/kg). The medium-term steers traded well between £1800 - £1950 (370 - 400p/kg).

A run of younger organic steers (11 - 13mths) saw British Blue to £1530 (378p/kg) & Aberdeen Angus to £1510 (387p/kg) from M/s W P Prior & Sons, Castle Combe.

The stronger heifers traded over £1850 topping at £1980 (381p/kg) for a Limousin from M/s A E & V Albutt & Sons, Winchcombe. The medium-term sorts were £1650 - £1800 (340 - 360p/kg).

APPLYING FOR LICENCES

From 2nd October 2023, keepers of TB restricted herds will be able to apply for a general licence to cover the movement of cattle to our Orange Markets. The general licence will be valid for the time between short interval tests. A new licence will need to be applied for after each short interval test. The licence will be published on Gov.UK for Vendors to download. Cattle to be herd or PMT tested in the last 90 days. Resolved IRs from a restricted holding need to be tested in the last 90 days and a TB204 is required. If from a TB clear holding resolved IR's do not need to be tested and may be moved under a general licence. Stock are unable to return home. Purchasers require an AFU.

Aberdeen Angus cows saw a top of £2200 (282p/kg) from M/s Bydemill Farm, Hannington & Hereford's to £1860 (274p/kg) from Mr M Francis, Minety. A good pedigree Aberdeen Angus bull sold to £2410 from M/s G Alvis & Son, Dumbleton.

Steers to £2630 Avg £1718 (377p/kg), Heifers to £2390 Avg £1553 (361p/kg)

Another good but shorter entry with the trade still remarkably strong on all types. The quality of the entry was very mixed today with both ends of the scale on offer.

The stronger short-term steers continue to sell well despite talks of a dropping beef trade with the best £2300 - £2500 (365 - 380p/kg) with a run of Charolais' from Mr S Coates, Haresfield topping at £2630 (376p/kg), £2590 (370p/kg) & £2430 (423p/kg). Strong Aberdeen Angus steers sold to £2390 (362p/kg) & £2370 (373p/kg) from Mr S Portch, Brinkworth.

The stronger medium-term steers looked very well sold between £1900 - £2100 (360 - 400p/kg) topping at £2340 (400p/kg) for Charolais' again from Mr S Coates, Haresfield & £2230 (381p/kg) for British Blues from Mr S Pinner, Andover. The next level traded between £1750 - £1850 (380 - 410p/kg).

A few more Friesian steers on offer met a good trade having got up to another level with the strength over £1500 topping at £1645 (300p/kg) & £1615 (320p/kg) from M/s M Maslin & Son, Brinkworth. The younger sorts all traded either side of £3kg.

A few stronger heifers met a very good trade with Mr S Coates, Haresfield dominating the top price at £2390 (402p/kg), £2310 twice (382p/kg & 385p/kg) & £2210 (368p/kg). A strong Aberdeen Angus heifer sold to £2200 (297p/kg) from M/s C Logan & Son, Brinkworth. The stronger medium-term heifers were generally £1900 - £2100 (360 - 380p/kg) topping at £2145 (358p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s R D Horton & Son, Broad Hinton. The next level were £1600 - £1800 (350 - 370p/kg) with the farming heifers were also a good trade between £1500 - £1650 (380 - 400p/kg).

The weaned calves & young store saw another extremely good trade with the stronger steers trading between £1250 - £1400 (380 - 420p/kg) topping at £1600 (372p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus (14mths) from Ms S Holder, Calne. A run of Hereford's (8 - 9mths) from M/s P D & A P Abbatt, Gotherington saw steers to £1450 (409p/kg), £1400 (424p/kg) & £1260 (467p/kg) with the heifers to £1370 (415p/kg) & £1265 (422p/kg).

A similar number forward with the trade still remarkably good following the lift last week and a general shortage and demand for Ramadan being a good combination. As expected trade a few pence back on the early and middle part of the week but dearer than the previous week. The entry was again quite mixed with a larger percentage of Hill breed x's and lesser breeds bring our averages back.

The handyweights (upto 45kg) saw the better sorts 365 – 370p/kg topping at 375p/kg £167 for 44½kg from Mr T Hosier who also topped the lightweights at 384p/kg £140 for 36½kg. The general handyweights were 355 – 360p/kg with the lesser sorts 335 – 350p/kg.

The medium weight hoggs were again a firmer trade with the few smart pens over 350p/kg topping at 359p/kg £174 for 48½kg again from Mr T Hosier. The next level were 335 – 345p/kg with the majority £160 - £170. The lesser breeds looked well sold between £150 - £160 (310 – 320p/kg).

Not many heavy hoggets saw a good trade between £170 - £176 with the super heavies to £187 for 67kg from Mr R Saunders & £186 for 61kg from Miss Z Gould.
