35 BREEDING & GRAZING COWS

11.30 am – Auctioneer: Jon Pullin

A good entry including a genuine dispersal of Gloucester, Hereford & Aberdeen Angus cows from Mr A J Hall, Pershore & Mr M Evans, Defford saw a ring full of buyers. Young, improving cows saw Hereford with a Hereford heifer to £1960 & bull calf to £1770. Stronger cows with Hereford bulls to £2510, £2230 & £2070. The majority traded between £1550 - £1700. In calf cows also sold well topping at £1810, £1490 & £1400 with the majority £1100 - £1200. Their pedigree Aberdeen Angus bulls sold to £2350 & £1750.

A Simmental heifer sold to £1910 (327p/kg) from M/s J A Jones & Son, Cricklade & Aberdeen Angus cows to £1520 (301p/kg) from Ms S Holder, Bremhill.

Steers to £2490 Avg £1788 (393p/kg), Heifers to £2190 Avg £1419 (365p/kg)

Another decent entry saw another very good, probably sharper trade with all ages and types extremely dear.

The short-term steers met an extremely good trade with the better sorts between £2200 - £2400 (390– 440p/kg) topping at £2490 (445p/kg) & £2480 (451p/kg) for Limousin steers from M/s A D & J A Morland, Solihull. Aberdeen Angus steers sold to £2300 (397p/kg) from Mr S Best, Leighton.

The stronger medium-term steers were another very good trade and sharper on the week trading between £1900 - £2100 (370 – 400p/kg) topping at £2280 (426p/kg) for a cracking bunch of Limousin steers (12 – 13mths) from M/s W E & M V Gash, Leigh who topped the day with a Limousin Rig steer at £2560 (385p/kg). The next level of steers looked well sold between £1750 - £1900 (370 – 420p/kg).

The stronger farming medium-term steers continue sale extremely well trading between £1550 - £1750 (370 – 440p/kg) with the next level £1450 - £1600 (380 – 410p/kg).

The younger steers & weaned calves again traded to great heights with Charolais steers (9 – 12mths) to £1670 (470p/kg) & £1670 (514p/kg) from M/s A T & P M Cutler & Son, Fairford. The stronger sorts were all £1350 - £1500 (380 – 440p/kg).

The few short-term heifers topped at £2190 (324p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s S & G Jenkins, Hilcott. The stronger medium-term heifers were also short in number and met a very good trade between £1800 - £1900 (340 – 360p/kg) with the next level probably looking the dearest between £1600 - £1700 (370 – 390p/kg). The farming heifers also looked well sold between £1400 - £1600 (350 – 370p/kg) generally.

The younger heifers also looked extremely well sold with Aberdeen Angus (13mths) to £1620 (381p/kg) & £1500 (395p/kg) from Mr S Best, Leighton & Charolais' (10 – 13mths) to £1505 (372p/kg) & £1460 (471p/kg) from M/s A T & P M Cutler & Son, Fairford.

An improved entry with larger numbers out all week following the improvement in trade again this week. A very mixed show of hoggets and many hill bred and lesser sorts dragging back the averages but still remarkably sold. More leaner hoggs in the fat section today also.

The handyweights (up to 45kg) were another very good, sharper trade with the better sorts trading between 415 – 420p/kg topping at 444p/kg £160 for 36kg from Mrs J Morgan. The next level were all 400 – 410p/kg. The general handyweights being mostly Herdwicks, Easycare's & Cheviots trading between 390 – 400p/kg and looking well sold.

The medium weight (46 – 52kg) hoggs were also a strong trade but no dearer with the better sorts trading between £185 - £190 topping at £200 for 51kg from M/s B & H Mifflin & Son. The next level were 375 – 385p/kg mostly £180 - £188. The heavier sorts were a good trade and sharper with the better sorts trading between 370 – 375p/kg mostly £195 - £200 topping £206 for 57kg from M/s M & P Howes. The next level were £185 - £190. The super heavies traded over £200 topping at £224 for 65kg from Mr K Smith who kindly donated to our charity.

CULL EWES (180) Numbers remain short in a lot of centres and dear keep getting dearer. The few best ewes traded over £200 to a top of £216 from Mrs J Morgan. The stronger Continental & Suffolk ewes were £175 - £190. The next level looking well sold between £160 - £175. The Mules saw the meat sorts to £160 with the half meated stronger framed ewes £130 - £140 & the next level £110 - £120. The stronger medium ewes also looked well sold between £120 - £140 & the half meated ewes £110 - £125. The small hill bred ewes saw the meat trading between £100 - £120, mediums £75 - £90 and plain £50 - £65. The plainer ewes were again another good trade with the bigger framed sorts £100 - £120 & mediums £90 - £100 and even the very plain £60 - £80.
