Steers to £2575 Avg £1370 (370p/kg), Heifers to £2050 Avg £1318 (349p/kg)

Another pleasing entry saw a good trade but definitely a shade easier with the dropping beef price starting to take effect.

The short-term Continental steers were still a good trade but easier on the week with the better sorts between £2200 - £2300 (360–380p/kg) topping at £2575 (368p/kg) & £2300 (387p/kg) for British Blue steers from M/s R Breakspear & Son, Standford Dingley. The Native breeds topped at £2260 (359p/kg) for Aberdeen Angus steers from Mr G Potheary, Cricklade.

The stronger medium-term steers again met another very good trade but also a shade easier trading between £1850 - £2100 (365 – 400p/kg) topping at £2110 (352p/kg) & £1970 (419p/kg) for Limousin steers from M/s A D & J A Morland, Shirley. The next level of steers still looked well sold but easier between £1650 - £1800 (370 – 400p/kg).

The stronger younger cattle traded well with Charolais steers (12 – 13mnths) to £1770 (381p/kg) from M/s W G Parrott & Son, Uffington & £1705 (371p/kg) from M/s B R & R V Gammond & Son, Lechlade. The better younger steers were mostly £1300 - £1500 (360 – 380p/kg). More longer-term steers being either lesser breeds or more dairy bred traded between £800 - £1000 (340 – 360p/kg).

A few short-term heifers on offer sold to a top of £2050 (315p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s E G & M R Price, Frocester & Hereford's to £2020 (331p/kg) from M/s G Ripley & Son, Daglingworth. The stronger medium-term heifers were still a good but also easier trade between £1750 - £1850 (350 – 380p/kg) topping at £1880 (372p/kg) for Limousin's from M/s A D & J A Morland, Shirley. The next level were between £1700 - £1800 (330 – 350p/kg). The farming heifers still a decent trade between £1400 - £1600 (330 – 350p/kg) generally.

A larger entry of weaned calves continues to sell well but also easier generally with strong Aberdeen Angus steers (9 – 10mnths) to £1590 (403p/kg) & £1540 (428p/kg) from M/s T R Limbrick & Son, Sherborne with heifers to £1280 (366p/kg). Simmental steers (8mnths) sold to £1310 (364p/kg) from Mrs V Scott, Braydon & Aberdeen Angus steers (7 – 10mnths) to £1225 (422p/kg) from Mr S Young, Garsington. Younger calves saw British Blue steers (5 – 6mnths) to £795 (388p/kg) from M/s Kingston & Sons, Tresham with their British Blue heifers (5 – 6mnths) to £700 (400p/kg). Limousin steers (5 – 7mnths) sold to £705 (415p/kg) from Mr D J Spratt, Aust with his Limousin heifers (5 – 8mnths) to £695 (434p/kg).

Hogget SQQ 408.9p/kg Overall Average 370.7p/kg

A decent entry with many centres struggling for numbers. Trade was better than expected and very pleasing throughout. Only a very few handyweight hoggets on offer with the better shaped sorts around 420p/kg topping at 424p/kg £178 for 42kg from Mr A Grindle. The next level looked well sold on the week between 410 – 418p/kg with the lesser breeds either side of 400p/kg and well sold for what was on offer.

The medium weight (46 – 52kg) hoggs were a good trade and better than expected and up on the week with the better sorts trading over 400p/kg topping at 423p/kg £201 for 47½kg from Mr H Todd. The next level were all in the 390p/kg bracket and mostly £188 - £195.

The heavier sorts having been harder work saw a slight improvement but no dearer than the medium weights with the better sorts £190 - £195 topping £209.50 for 55½kg from Mr H Todd.

32 sheep already pushed their 2 broad teeth trading approx. £15 - £20 less than lamb teeth equivalent.

Second quality sorts with younger lambs traded between £100 - £110 a life.

CULL EWES (210) Another decent entry and still remarkably good trade and again as dear as anywhere. The few best ewes traded over £200 topping at £250 from Mr M Hobbs. The stronger Continental & Suffolk ewes were mostly £180 - £200 with the next level looking well sold between £160 - £175. The Mules saw the stronger medium sorts to £170 with the half meated ewes £130 - £150 & the next level £120 - £130.

The stronger medium ewes also looked well sold between £135 - £160 & the half meated ewes £120 - £140. The small hill bred ewes saw the meat trading between £100 - £120, mediums £75 - £90 and plain £50 - £65.

The plainer ewes were again another good trade and probably dearer with the bigger framed sorts £120 - £130 & mediums £90 - £100 and even the very plain £60 - £80.

RAMS & HOGGETS (46) A very good show of rams saw the strong meat rams £180 - £200. Medium rams £150 - £160.
