A short entry met a remarkable trade on all types with many more needed. Aberdeen Angus bulls sold to £600 from M/s R & R Baker & £550, £535 & £525 from M/s C D & S M Rawlings. Friesian bulls sold to £400 from Mr M McNally & £310 from M/s A Webb & Son. Their Aberdeen Angus heifer topped at £605 & their British Blue heifer to £580. Aberdeen Angus heifers sold to £570 & £545 from M/s R & R Baker.

An Aberdeen Angus heifer and her Aberdeen Angus bull calf (4mnths) sold to £1700 from Mr M Pullin, Leonard Stanley. His incalf Saler heifer sold to £1400 & Beef Shorthorn grazing cow to £1550 (287p/kg). Strong Hereford cows sold to £1940 (279p/kg) & £1860 (278p/kg) from Mr N J Goulding, Newent.

116 STORE CATTLE

Steers to £1860 Avg £1443 (346p/kg), Heifers to £1670 Avg £1245 (338p/kg)

A much shorter entry of mostly younger cattle saw a very similar trade probably still too good for the current beef price and still ahead of many expectations. No short-term steers on offer with the stronger medium-term steers again met another good trade but as expected an easier trade with the uncertainty of the current beef trade between £1700 - £1800 (335 - 350p/kg) topping at £1860 (354p/kg) for British Blue steers from M/s P & P Horton, Broad Hinton. Beef Shorthorn steers sold to £1820 (350p/kg) from Mr N J Goulding, Newent. The next level of steers still looked a decent trade between £1600 - £1700 (330 - 350p/kg).

The general farming steers were a bit more selective trading between £1450 - £1600 (330 - 360p/kg).

The stronger younger cattle traded well and looking the dearest of the day with Simmental steers (14mnths) to £1760 (326p/kg) from Mr S Saveall, Swindon. Aberdeen Angus steers (14mnths) sold to £1735 (347p/kg) from Mr S Pinner, Andover. The majority of the better steers traded between £1250 - £1500 (350 - 370p/kg) with the next level £975 - £1150 (345 - 370p/kg).

The stronger medium-term heifers were still a good but also easier trade between £1500 - £1650 (330 - 360p/kg) topping at £1670 (348p/kg) for a British Blue from M/s P & P Horton, Broad Hinton. The next level being mostly younger cattle were between £1200 - £1350 (320 - 360p/kg). The farming & longer-term heifers still a decent trade between £1050 - £1150 (310 - 330p/kg) generally.

A very good entry with double the number on this sale last year and £1k dearer. Trade continue to hold well considered the numbers out nationally with the best lambs 480p/kg + topping at 500p/kg £190 for 38kg from M/s R J & B E Kimber. The good commercial lambs were 455 - 470p/kg with a few leaner or lesser bred sorts 440 - 450p/kg. Only a few heavier lambs sold to £200 for 51kg from Mrs J Morgan.

Another decent entry of mixed sorts saw a very good trade but not as sharp as last week's flyer but mostly due to what was on offer. Our increased buying support saw 8 buyers active and after hoggets.

The best handyweight hoggets in great demand trading over 430p/kg topping at 444p/kg twice £171 for 38½kg from Mr A Grindle & £200 for 45kg from Mr R Colbourne. The good meat commercial hoggets were all 405 – 415p/kg.

The medium weight (46 – 52kg) hoggs were also a good trade with the better sorts trading over 400p/kg topping at 413p/kg £190 for 46kg from Stowell Park Estate. All the better hoggs were all £190 - £200 topping at £206 for 52kg from M/s D J & A C Dando. The next level were 390 – 400p/kg and mostly £190 - £195. The lesser breeds and leaner types were mostly £180 - £185.

More heavier hoggs on offer with the better super heavies over £210 topping £221 for 82kg from Mr R Goodman. The 53 – 60kg were generally £195 - £210 with the next level £188 - £193.

64 sheep having pushed their 2 broad teeth trading approx. £15 - £20 less than lamb teeth equivalent.

STORE LAMBS & HOGGETS (28) A pen of young, small store lambs sold to £60. Plain hoggs saw the mediums between £100 - £120.

EWES & LAMBS (44 & 54) Both end of the scale of offer saw a good trade. The few stronger sorts well sold with Suffolk ewes with doubles to £382 (£127 a life) & 3 Suffolk ewes with 5 lambs to £335 (£125.60 a life) from M/s A & A Smith. Mule hoggs with single lambs to £265 (£132 a life) from M/s J W Emmerson & Son. Smart Continental ewes with singles to £232 (£116 a life) from Ms L Walker. The rest were rare breeds trading between £40 - £100 a couple,

CULL EWES (316) A pleasing, larger entry saw another good trade but a bit more selective than the previous week. Only a few best Continental ewes traded over £210 topping at £225. The stronger Continental & Suffolk ewes were mostly £180 - £200 with the next level looking well sold between £165 - £180. The Mules saw the stronger medium sorts £170 - £180 with the half meated ewes £140 - £150.

The stronger medium ewes also looked well sold between £140 - £160 & the half meated ewes £125 - £140. The small hill bred ewes saw the meat trading between £110 - £120, mediums £90 - £110 and plain £70 - £80.

The plainer ewes were again another good trade and probably dearer with the bigger framed sorts £120 - £130 & mediums £110 - £120 and even the very plain £80 - £100.

RAMS & HOGGETS (20) A good show of rams saw the strong meat rams £190 - £210, medium rams £140 - £170. Wethers & hoggets £150 - £173.

STORE PIGS (42) A decent trade with the stronger sorts over £60 topping at £95 from Mr D Neal & £75 from M/s Butts Farm. Medium sorts £45 - £60 & smaller sorts mostly £15 - £30.
