Rearing Calves Bulls to £685, Heifers to £470

Another sharp trade at Cirencester today. A smart British Blue bull topped at £685 from M/s A Webb & Son with others to £470 & £460 from M/s Lydney Park Farms. Simmental bulls sold to £475 from M/s E J Pike & Son.

British Ble heifers to £470 again from M/s Lydney Park Farms with Hereford heifers to £440 from Mr H J Vincent & Simmental heifers to £430 from M/s E J Pike & Son.

6 GRAZING COWS

A good trade saw an incalf Simmental cow to £1630 & a British Blue grazing cow to £1350 (237p/kg) from M/s R & V Scott, Braydon. Strong Limousin cows sold to £2050 (268p/kg) & Longhorn's to £1700 (270p/kg) from M/s Mowles Farms, Tetbury. Limousin cows to £1870 (271p/kg) from Mr B Yeates, Nupend.

167 STORE CATTLE

Steers to £2370 Avg £1602 (344p/kg), Heifers to £2070 Avg £1410 (320p/kg)

An improved entry with a show of stronger cattle on offer met a similar trade with some probably a shade dearer despite another drop in the beef trade.

A super run of outlying Charolais steers from M/s A & W Hancock, Slad sold to £2370 twice (362 & 359p/kg), £2300 (393p/kg) & £2180 (386p/kg).

The shorter-term & stronger medium-term steers again met another good trade between £1850 - £2000 (325 – 345p/kg) topping at £2140 (315p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s O Nutland Contracting, Wootton Bassett. The next level of steers still looked a decent trade between £1700 - £1800 (330 – 350p/kg).

The general farming steers were again selective trading between £1500 - £1600 (330 – 360p/kg).

The stronger younger cattle traded well and looking the dearest of the day with British Blue steers (14mnths) to £1785 (347p/kg) & £1760 (371p/kg) from M/s O Nutland Contracting, Wootton Bassett. Smart Limousin steers (8mnths) to £1575 (332p/kg) from M/s Mowles Farms, Tetbury. The majority of the better steers traded between £1250 - £1500 (350 – 370p/kg) with the next level £1075 - £1150 (335 – 370p/kg).

Top prices in the heifers were all Aberdeen Angus heifers topping at £2070 (329p/kg) from M/s Cullimore Farm, Stroud & £1880 (290p/kg) & £1875 (305p/kg) from M/s H E Farnsworth & Son, Chedworth Laines. The stronger medium-term heifers were still a good between £1650 - £1700 (310 – 330p/kg) topping at £1750 (318p/kg) for Bazadaise heifers from M/s M T & I B Scott & Son, Purton. The next level were a similar trade between £1300 - £1500 (310 – 340p/kg). The farming & longer-term heifers still a decent trade between £1050 - £1150 (310 – 330p/kg) generally.

Lamb SQQ 451.9p/kg Overall Average 451.7p/kg

As requested a large entry needed and with almost double to this sale last year and rewarded with a very good trade (Almost £1kg dearer than last year). The best export lighter lambs (36 – 39kg) traded over 460p/kg topping at 479p/kg £175 for 36½kg from Mr A R Wilcox with the good commercial lambs 445 – 455p/kg & the few looser coated & leaner sorts 425 – 430p/kg. The medium weight lambs (39½ – 42kg) were a similar trade with the best also over 460p/kg topping at 478p/kg £196 twice for 41kg from M/s R J & B E Kimber & Mrs H Whitcombe. The good commercial lambs were all 440 – 460p/kg with a few leaner or lesser bred sorts looking the dearest between 420 – 440p/kg. Only a few heavier lambs sold to £200 for 45kg from Mr J W Watkins & £220 for 50kg from M/s W Bartlett & Son.

A pleasing entry and almost double last year also and as predicted an improved trade with the forthcoming festival.

An entry of mixed sorts with all well sold and both ends of the scale on offer, and our increased buying support saw 8 buyers active and after hoggets.

The best handyweight hoggets in great demand trading between 430 – 440p/kg topping at 462p/kg £180 for 39kg from Mr A Grindle. The good meat commercial hoggets were all 420 – 430p/kg.

The medium weight (46 – 52kg) hoggs were also a good trade with the better sorts trading over 420p/kg topping at 430p/kg £198 for 46kg from Mr D Turner. All the better hoggs were all £195 – £205 topping at £215 for 52kg from Mr M Gillett. The next level were 410 – 420p/kg and mostly £190 – £195. The lesser breeds and leaner types looked the dearest and mostly £185 – £190.

More heavier hoggs on offer and taking a big lift with the better super heavies over £220 topping £230 twice for 78kg from Heckfield Park Farm & 63kg from M/s S J & C J Steel. The 53 – 58kg were generally £200 – £210 with the next level £186 – £195.

98 sheep having pushed their 2 broad teeth trading approx. £20 – £30 less than lamb teeth equivalent topping at £248 & £231 from Heckfield Park Farm.

CULL EWES (494) A much larger entry and as usually happens just before the festival a slight ease in the trade. Don't be mistaken the trade is still extremely good and well ahead of many other local centres.

Only a few best Continental ewes on offer traded over £200 topping at £230. The stronger Continental & Suffolk ewes were mostly £175 – £190 with the next level looking well sold between £160 – £175. The Mules saw the stronger medium sorts £170 – £180 with the half meated ewes £140 – £150.

The stronger medium ewes still looked well sold between £140 – £160 & the half meated ewes £125 – £140. The small hill bred ewes saw the meat trading between £100 – £120, mediums £80 – £100 and plain £60 – £70.

The plainer ewes were again another good trade with the bigger framed sorts £120 – £130 & mediums £110 – £120 and even the very plain £80 – £100.

RAMS, WETHERS, HOGGETS & GOATS (42) A good show of rams saw the strong meat rams £180 – £200, medium rams £140 – £160. Wethers sold to £200.
