Rearing Calves Bulls to £772, Heifers to £740

A cracking trade again today saw Aberdeen Angus bulls to £772, £745 & £735 from Mr D H Bragg. Young fresh Simmental bulls to £630 twice from M/s E J Pike & Son. Hereford bulls to £450 from M/s R J & N J Clarke.

Aberdeen Angus heifers sold to £740, £670 & £650 again from Mr D H Bragg with Simmental heifers to £630 from M/s E J Pike & Son & British Blue's to £630 from M/s D & D Smart.

Steers to £2540 Avg £1667 (340p/kg), Heifers to £1820 Avg £1368 (325p/kg)

Another pleasing for the time of year saw a similar trade to last week and all cattle trading at high levels and looking well sold aided by a good show of stronger farming cattle.

A few short-term steers on offer looked a good trade with 22 steers over £2000 topping at £2540 (339p/kg) for an Aberdeen Angus from M/s E G Hedges & Son, Shepperdine. A grand run of strong British Blue steers from M/s G E Gardner & Son, St Catherines sold to £2190 (329p/kg) & £2115 (325p/kg).

The stronger medium-term steers again met another very strong trade and as dear as the previous week between £1850 - £2000 (330 – 340p/kg). Another run of Limousin steers from R B Lewis Partnership, Leamington Spa sold to £2080 (344p/kg) & £2005 (343p/kg). The next level also looked well sold between £1700 - £1850 (340 – 360p/kg) being mostly native breeds.

The stronger younger cattle traded well and again looking the dearest of the day with the stronger sorts generally £1650 - £1750 (350 – 400p/kg) with the next level £1400 - £1600 (380 – 400p/kg).

A decent show of heifers with the stronger medium-term sorts continuing at similar levels with the better sorts £1700 - £1800 (335 – 350p/kg) topping at £1820 twice for Aberdeen Angus from M/s W, A & D Hillier, Sherston & M/s E G Hedges & Son, Shepperdine. The next level were also a strong trade between £1600 - £1750 (330 – 350p/kg). The younger heifers also traded exceptionally well with the stronger sorts £1450 - £1600 (360 – 380p/kg).

The weaned calves & young stores again looked exceptionally dear with some very smart British Blue steers (12mnths) to £1675 (399p/kg) & heifers £1530 (378p/kg) from M/s M & R Windel, Wroughton. Aberdeen Angus steers (10mnths) to £1490 (355p/kg) & £1480 (380p/kg) from Cimarron Partnership, Minety. Hereford heifers (11 – 12mnths) sold to £1255 (306p/kg) from Mr D E Meredith, Greenhill. A run of Sussex steers (9 – 12mnths) sold to £1040 (336p/kg) & £940 (336p/kg) from M/s R & J Burr, Sevenhampton.

Another decent entry with over 1000 more lambs sold this year compared to last year and again the continued good trade bringing lambs out earlier & lighter. Trade has eased this week but firmed again on Thursday and still remarkably good.

The best handyweight export lambs were all 440 – 450p/kg topping at 458p/kg £190 for 41½kg from M/s P & R Clark. The good commercial lambs traded between 430 – 445p/kg with the next level looked the dearest in comparison between 420 – 430p/kg.

Not many medium weight lambs (43 - 45kg) saw the better sorts topping at £204 for 44½kg from M/s P & R Clark with the majority £190 - £195. The few heavier lambs traded around £200.

The medium ewes saw the better sorts £150 - £160 & the next level £110 - £130. Smaller ewes saw the meat £90 - £110.
